Stainless Steel Track has come to dominate the outdoor track market.

Stainless steel track, while not popular in smaller scales like HO or N, has distinct advantages for large scale. Leading the advantages is the excellent corrosion or rust characteristics and resistance to dirt build up.

In the outdoor environment of many large scale railroad empires, track rusting and dirt are significant issues. Countless hours are spent by the large scale modeler cleaning track. With stainless steel, cleaning track becomes unnecessary. The large scale modeler is able to spend more time running

trains. **About Stainless.**

Stainless steel is an alloy based in iron with a minimum of 10.5% chromium and less then 1% carbon content. An alloy is the combination of one or more materials to create a new material having the characteristics of the source materials. Other materials may also be present in the stainless steel alloy. These include metals like nickel and manganese, and trace amounts of silicon, sulfur and molybdenum.

Due to the chromium content, an invisible surface film is created. The surface film gives stainless steel its resistance to corrosion. The non-rusting characteristic that is coveted by large scale modelers. The presence of other materials like nickel helps to improve the cleanliness of the stainless steel. Dirt is less likely to adhere to the surface of stainless steel adding to its suitability for large scale track.

It has now been over 5 years since we started producing a full line of Stainless Steel Track. At the time many questioned the practicality of stainless steel track. After all, stainless steel did not conduct electricity as well as brass, it was tried in HO scale and did not work and was not popular in O-Gauge. Above all, people expressed concerns about the additional costs stainless steel and that it was difficult to work with.

Well, over the past 5 years Aristo-Craft Stainless Steel Track has proven its critics wrong. Stainless steel's many advantages have demonstrated they significantly outweigh initial concerns including conductivity and additional cost. Over the past 5 years stainless steel track has been extremely successful. Today, Aristo-Craft





Before Aristo-Craft's introduction of stainless steel track, the most popular metal used for large-scale track is brass. Brass is an alloy made of copper and zinc. Brass track was once popular in the smaller scales like HO and N. However, in the early 1980's nickel silver track began to replace brass track. Once the advantages of nickel silver became apparent to modelers in HO and N scale nickel silver dominated. Now, many manufactures of brass track in HO and N scale are discontinuing the line. Stainless steel has replaced brass for outdoor railroading like nickel silver replace brass in HO and N scale.

Stainless steel, like nickel silver of the smaller scales has many advantages over brass. Stainless steel is less susceptible to dirt then brass. Where dirt adheres to brass, it does not adhere to stainless steel.

In the outdoor environment of many large scale railroads, soil from the surrounding area tends to get on the rails. Soil will adhere to brass. Soil does not conduct electricity well. Soil is less likely to adhere to stainless steel. For the most part, soil merely falls off

Moisture has an effect on track. When brass track becomes wet, it tends to loose its electrical conductivity, can corrode, and dirt builds on the surface. Moisture has less effect on stainless steel. Stainless steel does not loose electrical conductivity. Corrosion does not occur and dirt does not build on the surface of the stainless steel rail.

Ware from locomotive and car wheels fall off of stainless steel rail. On brass rail, ware from locomotive and car wheels stay on the head of the rail. This reduces conductivity. Performance of locomotives and cars that receive power from the rails is reduced.

Both brass and stainless steel will oxidize. However there is a vast difference in the effects of the oxidization of the two metals. When brass oxidizes, it looses its electrical conductivity. When stainless steel oxidizes, electrical conductivity is not lost.

Five years ago when we introduced stainless steel track, there were claims from others of the virtues of "virgin brass". Perhaps those that made the claim were concerned about the impact of our stainless steel track. To this day we cannot compare stainless steel to virgin brass. In truth there is no such thing as virgin brass. Using the term "virgin brass" suggests that the brass comes straight from the brass mine. Brass like stainless steel is an alloy. There are no brass mines.

Stainless versus Nickel silver.

Nickel silver is brass with around 12% nickel added. The presence of nickel is what gives nickel silver track the characteristics that made it so popular with hobbyists in HO and N scale. Nickel silver has superior electrical conductivity characteristics to brass. It stays cleaner, does not loose conductivity do to oxidization, and is far easier to work with.

However, these advantages in HO and N scale do not translate well into large scale. Nickel silver has many of the same characteristics as brass in the outdoor

environment of many large-scale railroads. Nickel silver suffers from many of the same dirt problems that brass does. Dirt and soil adheres to nickel silver.

Furthermore, do to being composed mostly of brass nickel silver will tarnish. This is particularly apparent outdoors. After a healthy does of snow or rain, nickel silver track will need to be cleaned just like brass. Stainless steel can withstand snow or rain without the need for cleaning.

Stainless Versus Stainless.

Not all stainless steel is created equal. There are different grades for different purposes. Depending on the intended use of the stainless steel, differing amounts of materials are used. Some stainless steel has higher chromium content then others. The level of carbon in the stainless steel is another factor. Other materials like nickel or silicon affects the characteristics of stainless steel.

Likewise, there are different grades of stainless steel used for large scale track. Typically, other manufacturers of stainless steel track use AISI type 430 stainless steel. We have selected AISI type 304 stainless steel

Stainless versus price.

Stainless steel track has a higher selling price then brass track. M.S.R.P. is about 15% more for stainless steel track then the M.S.R.P. for brass track. This is not necessarily do to the cost of the metal. The difference in price is related to the cost of production of the rail itself. Because of the nature of the metals, stainless steel requires additional manufacturing effort. Thereby increasing the cost of the track.

Stainless Steel and Wheels.

There have been reports of stainless steel track causing excessive ware on the wheels of locomotives and cars. It is claimed that

because stainless steel is hard, wheels ware out faster then wheels run on brass track. In testing these claims could not be replicated. Testing included two similar loops of track, one of stainless steel the second of brass track and similar locomotives and cars, Dash-9's and Evans Boxcars. After several hundred hours of testing, there was no appreciable difference between the wheels of the locomotives and cars run on the stainless steel track and locomotives and cars run on the brass track.

Stainless Steel and Train Performance.

It has been observed that train performance is better on stainless steel then brass track on powered rail. Locomotives run faster, smoke units operate better, and lighting in cars work better on stainless steel track then on brass. This phenomenon was observed by people who were mixing brass and stainless steel track. They noticed that when the train transitioned from the brass track to the stainless steel track, it would perform better. When the train would transition back to the brass track, the performance of the train would diminish. The phenomenon occurred regardless of the location of track power pickups.

There is truth to the phenomenon of improved train performance on stainless steel track. It is the result of the differences in oxidization properties of stainless steel and brass. Oxidization of brass inhibits electrical conductivity while oxidization of stainless steel does not. Because oxidization does not inhibit electrical conductivity of stainless steel, locomotives and cars have electrical power transferred to them more easily resulting in better train performance.

Conclusion

Finally, the silvery color is far more scale looking than brass, so the realism factor jumps tremendously.

Silver color, nonmagnetic, good conductor, no oxidation and no cleaning make stainless steel the logical choice for garden railroading. We will supply stainless steel track in all of our straight track sizes, curve track diameters, switch sizes, crossings and all other track componants.

Is the additional cost of stainless steel track worth it? Well to know, ask anybody who uses stainless steel. Or try stainless steel track for yourself. See the virtues for yourself. See if you want to think stainless!

DCC AND BATTER

Laying track outside leaves you at the mercy of Mother Nature with high Summer temperatures and cold Winters with ground heaving. It's nearly impossible to have a perfect track outdoors without constant maintenance. Keeping the track conductive requires high maintenance in cleaning and checking connections for conductive continuity on a regular basis. Do you want to spend time maintaining your layout or running trains? The answer is obvious and the solution is as well. Battery operation controlled by through the air DC is the answer to these problems. Depending on where you live the problem is more or less, but affects all users in some way. DCC operation through the track is another solution, but again mostly dependent on good conductive track and a solid roadbed. There is also always a current drop as well to contend with in G Gauge locos, which makes the trains run slower than is prototypical.


Aristo-Craft will support all methods of operation, but we are recommending the battery/RC method as the most practical for easy running with less maintenance. Virtually, every locomotive made by Aristo-Craft Trains for the past 5 years has a battery plug attached to the front and rear of each locomotive for easy attachment to a trailing car equipped with batteries and a radio control receiver. Our special wiring to a metal wheel on the car provides ground plane avoidance and thus extending the range of the radio transmitter transmission searching for the receiver antenna that is | ART-55496 Battery Car

hidden by the antenna close to the ground. The rail of the track then helps to become the ground for the signal and is a many times more effective than a thin piece of receiver wire that's a few inches from the ground.

Aristo-Craft is offering a finished car complete with the antenna, ground plane wire, metal wheel axle, receiver and battery already installed and will optionally include a battery charger is you don't have one already. Aristo-Craft Trains also sells a Y connector for two batteries and thus can double the running time from the standard pack. We use Lithium Ion batteries in a pack with 6 cells and each cell is protected separately by a circuit board during charging. Lithium Ion provides the best power to weight option and our pack provides 21 volts at 2 amps and two packs extends that life time by providing 4 amps, but still 21 volts. The battery will provide power for the trains and the remote control receiver simultaneously and the battery is easily replaceable through the door of the stock car where it's installed.

We chose a stock car as the venting for heat dissipation is automatic and thus, no fan is required.

The battery recharge time is about 4 hours, so we recommend that spares are kept charging and on hand when the batteries in use run out. The battery pack's themselves are held in place on the car floor by double-sided Velcro and are pulled off the car floor when exchange is required. The receiver board is attached in a similar manner and need never be removed other than for servicing. The car features a plug on one end to plug into the locomotive and it provides power to the locomotive with all of the features normally available from a power pack that had to be in a fixed position as is the user of this type of device. The current CRE-55470 hand held transmitter can control up to 100 locomotives on the same track or adjoining tracks and can simultaneously operate accessories such as switches or sound devices installed in the locomotive.





The Aristo-Craft/Crest CRE-55470 system will keep up to 100 trains running on cruise control without conflicts from simultaneous users. This result goes through the airways and is not dependent on signals through the tracks that are dependent on conductive track for accurate reception of the signals. As a matter of fact the track is for steering the trains and is not used to power the trains at all. No power supply is required, though one can be used and the battery option eliminated. This is totally optional and if the user has an investment in powered track this can still be used along with the radio control features and not the battery. The CRE-55475 accessory receiver can be mounted in the loco and the bell and horn/whistle can be operated from the buttons on the transmitter.

Also, remote switches and other accessories can be operated from out new trackside battery box that provides sufficient power to the accessories necessary to operate them and will have enough current to last a week before recharging or replacing.

Our new 900 mhz RCC onboard system CRE55700 will allow the use of NMRA DCC standardized signals through the airwaves without the worry about clean track as the signal will go directly to the onboard decoder as a radio wave.. This can be run on battery power or track power, since the signal is coming through the air waves and not through the track and thus offers the most choices possible of any similar system on the market. I'm attaching


CRE-55610 Li-On Battery Pack & CRE-55620 Li-On Battery Charger

a concept drawing of the transmitter and we are working on what features will be made available to the hobbyist as we speak here.

Most importantly, we will be able to operate the sound and all lighting functions and many more functions from the transmitter as well as all of the same features that are now only available with track signal DCC. Not only that, we can control up to 999 trains and accessories from the one hand held and you can identify every locomotive you have by both description and road number for easy visual identification.




We have done brilliantly with our ELITE CRE55465 Switching Power Supply, but we know that we live in the era of DCC and DCC Sound Boards. We wanted to offer more power for those users and wanted to

continue the switching power concept. The Everest does just that. At 24V and 15 AMPS we have reached the top of the power curve for most consumer electronics and Aristo-Craft Trains builds it equipment to perform within this limit. Any more and we're selling welding torch level equipment.

Electronic and motor efficiency are totally different if you exceed these limits, so that's why we're calling this one the Everest or our peak performance unit. It's built to lab level quality and is above and beyond normal consumer level products. This is for the top level G45 hobbyist and will be the equal of the super locomotives now on the market. It still requires either our Train Engineer or 5401 Controller to allow it to perform.

We're also making rail clamps for our rail. These rail clamps are lower cost than others on the market and allow you to make better use of our rail that does not come pre-drilled for standard rail joiners. This is a product that you should put on your staple list. It's a product we have taken over from the now retired Walt Schwarz of Istra the source of our rail bender. He recommended we keep the rail clamps alive. The rail clamps are stock #'s ART11930 brass rail clamp, 11940 plated rail clamp for stainless steel track, and 11950 wire lugs for electrical connections. Please give them a try.

Taking Inventory

This is generally the time of year when everyone is taking inventory of one thing or another. Allan and John, and just about everyone else who isn't tied to a desk in the office, are going to embark on their annual "climb through the shelves" to inventory all of our product in the warehouse. It's a fun exercise ... well, not really. But it needs to be done. So does an inventory of all of your garden railroad stuff.

If you haven't taken an inventory of your trains, accessories, and related jungue, it's a really great exercise. You can start with a blank Excel spreadsheet. It doesn't have to be anything fancy, and you don't have to be an Excel wiz, but you do need a bit of patience and some persistence, because you won't do your inventory in one sitting.

Here are some ideas on how to create your own inventory spreadsheet.

Open up MS Excel and you'll see a blank spreadsheet with a number of tabs along the bottom called "Sheet 1, Sheet 2, Sheet 3". Somebody at MS must have known we'd be starting out with three workbooks, but they named them wrong! Put your cursor over the first tab, right click, select "Rename" from the pop-up menu and the tab will turn black. Once that happens just go ahead and type in the new name, "Home". This workbook will be the home page for your inventory.

It's easy to put your favorite picture in the middle of the page. Just put your cursor

go up to the top of the window and find the Insert command. Click on it and a menu will drop down. There are menus at almost every click! Look for the "Picture" command. Click it and you'll be prompted with another menu. Select "from File" and you'll be taken to a window that will let you search your computer for the picture you

in a cell at the center of your screen and want. Once you've found the picture, just click on it and then on "insert" and wha-la ...the picture is in your spreadsheet. You can resize the picture by clicking on it and grabbing one of the corner buttons with your cursor and dragging it diagonally outwards ... pushing it diagonally inwards will make the photo smaller. You can make the picture a hyperlink to your favorite website buy clicking on it once and then selecting the "world over a chain-link" icon on the top of the page. That will get you... guess what ... another window where you can add in the HTTP:// address you want to link to. Simple! No?



You can even make your tabs different colors just by right clicking on the tab and choosing "tab color" from the ... yup ...

Figure 1 shows a sample of a simple Home Page I created in Excel for my inventory.

If you've followed along this far, the scary part is over. From here on in, it's just a matter of setting up some data entry fields and adding the data ... and pictures if you want them.

Click on the "Locomotive" tab that you created and you'll be presented an empty spreadsheet. It's made up of Rows (across) and Columns (up & down). Each Row has a number and each Column has a letter. You'll probably want to use the Columns for consistent data fields, and the Rows to identify the data for a given item.

Let's give it a try.

In Row 3, Column A, put the words "American Steam" (This is because some of you will be adding a section for "Euro Steam" later on ... I know, I know ... not everyone is as loyal to Aristo Red & Yellow as I am!) Just put your cursor over that cell, left click and it will be highlighted, then just type. Now skip down to Row #4 and in the B Column put the word "Type". In Column C put the word "Manufacturer". In Column D, put the word "Part Number". Keep adding Column headings until you've included all of the info you want to capture about an item. You might want to eapture about an item. You might want to have a column for "Condition", "Cost" (what you paid for it), "Location" (if you're soooooo organized that you have a shelf-space slotting system) and then don't forget to have a column for "Photo". If you have digital photos of your loco, you can put it here.

Once you've set it up, here's what it might look like:

You can stretch any of the rows or columns to any size you need them to be by grabbing the dividing line (out in the light brown area) with your cursor and dragging them to the new size.

Don't be afraid of Excel ... play a little on a rainy day ... and you can have the inventory program you've been wanting. The joy of building it yourself is that it's exactly what you want it to be!

Try it, you'll be amazed by how much "stuff" you've acquired over the years, and I bet you'll even come up with some car or loco you don't even remember buying!

And don't forget to "SAVE" it every once and a while.

New Items News & Editorial

HAPPY NEW YEAR!

Well another New Year is upon us. I am sure 2007 will be half over before I figure our where 2006 went. Then again it feels like it was just yesterday we were celebrating the new millennium.

Tovs For Tots

A few weeks before Christmas Lewis, Navin, Ron & Sue Wenger, myself and the ever adorable bear TATE visited the Toys for Tots display in Bethlehem, PA. Every year Train Time (www.traintimeshow.com) a TV show dedicated to model railroading hosts a huge train display during the holiday season to benefit the Marine Corps Toys For Tots campaign.

Bob Metz, Kevin Yutz, Nelson Fogle and the rest of the group were great hosts. They even provided a great cake! See TATE cutting the cake? Thanks for the good time.

E-8 Update

While we were supposed to have the E-8's before Christmas, delivery has been delayed. Involving cosmetic issues, the locomotives were not made to our standards and sent back to the factory. The factory has found solutions will fix the issues and get the locomotives back to us. With luck the Santa Fe and Burlington locomotives will be here in the next month or two. The rest of the road names hopefully will be returned to us in the spring.

Keep in mind these were only cosmetic issues not mechanical. Cosmetic issues are appearance visual or noise while mechanical involves the proper operation of the locomotive. The locomotives operated and functioned properly.

There were two issues that caused us to reject the E-8 locomotives. The first involved the side frames of the locomotives. The side frames were warped. The warping was not only visually objectionable but also caused contact between the side frame and locomotive wheels resulting in an objectionable squealing noise. Again, this issue had no mechanical effect on the locomotives. The locomotives operated perfectly.

The second issue involved the long grilles on the sides of the locomotives. The grilles where bowing and not laying flat against the sides of the locomotives. This issue was



also resolved. A small modification to the grilles allows them to lay flat against the bodies.

There is an irony involving the Santa Fe and Burlington locomotives. Both of these models have "chromed" sides. The chroming process takes longer then the typical painting process resulting in the Santa Fe and Burlington locomotives being finished and shipped last. When the issues involving the side frames and grilles were discovered, the Santa Fe and Burlington locomotives were still at the factory. The locomotives are supposed to be the first to have the cosmetic issues fixed. If there are no unexpected delays, we should have the Santa Fe and Burlington locomotives by the end of February. The ironic result is the people who would have gotten their E-8 locomotive last will likely get them first.

Track Diagrams

In This issue of the Insider I have included Aristo-Craft Track diagrams. These plans are designed for use when creating track plans. Print out the diagrams and make copies. The diagrams are designed to be ½" to a 1" scale so watch your printer settings.

I placed the diagrams on the website with the Track section in the Catalog. After directing several people to the diagrams for layout planning I have received no negative feedback. Then again I have received no positive feedback either, so it ain't saying much.

Email Address Updates

I frequently get emails from people telling me their email address has changed. Usually there is nothing I can do.

It is typically pointless to tell me about your email address change. Ninety-nine percent of the time I can't change the email address


in the first place. We use a bulk email service for sending emails like the Insider and In-Stock/New Arrivals notices to our customers and dealers. The email service we use does not allow me to change an email address. Well it is not easy to change an email address. Therefore, you need to change your email address yourself.

When you change your email address, open one of the bulk emails we sent you like the Insider Newsletter notification. On the bottom of the email there is a link for changing your profile. Click on the link and follow the instructions for changing your email address. Be careful. At the bottom of the email there is also a link for removing yourself from the email list. Click on that link and you will no longer receive emails from us creating other headaches.

The reason for the difficulty for me to change your email address is part of the anti-spam features of the email service. The service is entirely permission based. Not do you have to accept continuing receiving the emails, hence the remove me link, but the administrator cannot change an email address. This effectively prevents the email service from being used to send spam. In order for me to change your email address I first have to remove your existing account then create a new account with your new email address. A very time consuming process. So please if you are changing your email address, don't send me an email. Instead click change your email address yourself by changing your profile.


