ARISTO-CRAFT TRACK PRICES GOING UP: THE FULL STORY

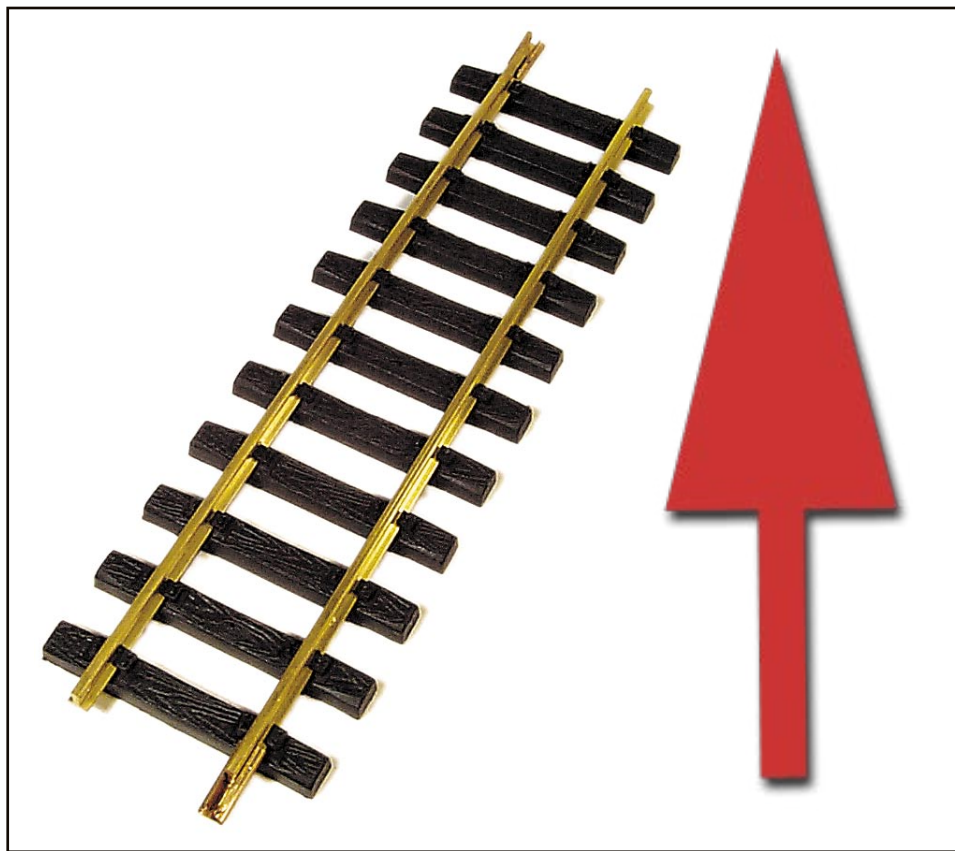
On June 18th, Lewis Polk, president of Aristo-Craft Trains, delivered the news that Aristo-Craft track prices would be doubled immediately as a result of the skyrocketing prices of the commodity metals used to make brass and stainless steel track.

The news was met with shock and surprise amongst customers across the board. While some felt anger at the price increase, others took the news as a sign of a rapidly changing global marketplace.

Here now is a summary of information about the price change, as written by Lewis Polk and TATE on the Aristo-Craft Trains Forum, Aristo-Craft's online community web bulletin board, and in correspondence this past month..

The initial announcement from Lewis Polk began...

Dear All, I don't know how to write this letter without the marketplace thinking we're profiteering on the loss of a major competitor in the track business, but the truth is that copper



prices have tripled in the past few years. Copper is a world commodity and our contract pricing ran out.

Copper is 70% of the raw commodity that goes into our brass track and

we can't make up the differences in volume. The hard fact is that we are going to double the price of our track immediately or not be able to

deliver track. This is the result of hard bargaining in light of the more than tripling in price of the commodity involved. After an equally high rise in price for steel in the world marketplace, stainless steel track will also rise in price, too.

TATE, Aristo-Craft Trains' website bulletin board representative, followed up with...

Why did we raise our price so much? We have no monopoly. Others still sell brass track and their pricing will follow the path upward as soon as they need to produce their next shipment and buy new supplies.

We buy our metals on contract in the open commodities market. Copper, the major component in brass track, has risen exponentially over the past three years. We've not kept up with that rise, instead lowering our profits to keep our track as the best price/value proposition in the market, and

hoping that sanity would begin to rule in the commodity markets. Our hopes were crushed with our last raw materials chase.

We were faced with the prospect of stopping track production or taking a large price increase. We felt we best served the hobby by continuing to produce, albeit at a higher cost and thus end price.

Here are two facts from the global raw material commodities market:

Stainless grade 304 sheet steel cwt contracts on 1/5/05 were priced at U.S. \$67.90.

Stainless grade 304 sheet steel cwt contracts on 6/1/07 were priced at U.S. \$240.00

Copper per pound contracts on 1/5/05 were priced at U.S. \$1.42.

Copper per pound contracts on 6/15/07 were priced at U.S. \$3.42.

Price source = Wall Street Journal Commodity Futures Price Report 6/19/07

Any business that can sustain that level of raw materials cost increase and not at least double their finished product price was stealing from you to start with. You can't deliver end product for less than the sum cost of materials, labor, shipping and factory overhead. That's a quick road to the end of a business.

Talk with an electrician and see what they have to say about the price of copper wire and what they are now charging customers vs. what they charged a year to eighteen months ago. Talk with a contractor who uses brass flashing or ornamental brass items in their construction projects and see what they say.

It's hard on all of us in the hobby. It's also the reality of the raw materials marketplace.

We were honest and upfront in

our announcement. One of the manufacturers had to be first to call the pricing, as it needs to be. I'm certain that anyone who uses brass or stainless steel in their products will have to bite the same bullet very shortly, or face getting out of solid brass or solid SS track production.

It's not happy news for anyone.

Lewis Polk then talked further in-depth about the background of the price increase...

My mistake was not following the price of copper in world markets. When we placed our annual order, it went in at the current pricing as offered by the supplier. It wasn't until production started and copper was about to be purchased that the realization hit the maker.

Then came the notification without warning, even though the orders had been on hand for at least 6 months or more. Track takes 6-9 months for delivery from the time we order, so we did not have this knowledge to change pricing at the start of the year. Two years ago, I paid \$1.00 for gas; now, it is triple the cost. However, I did this weekly and noticed the change. The copper pricing is even more irrational as there is no shortage of the refinery equivalent, nor of the raw materials. I just didn't notice when we

placed our orders, nor received any notification about it until Friday.

It's inexcusable that we didn't raise prices progressively, instead having to do a mid-season price change that we have never done in our past. It's that or shut down our track deliveries totally. I realize the shock to the marketplace, but we have no choice if we wish to continue as a supplier of track. We had hoped that copper pricing would return to reality, but today's world leaves commodity pricing irrational. If the commodity price of copper changes we will reflect the price changes on a quarterly basis in the future. Stainless steel pricing has been in the same mode and price is doubling as well.

Lewis Polk explained about the other costs involved in making track...

The other 30% of brass rail is zinc and that price has risen equally if not more. Ask any die-cast car collector about the prices in that field. Also, plastic resin made out of oil has risen, too, as has all of the costs of labor (even in China), the packaging papers, the cost of containers and shipping (with fuel surcharges, etc.). Not only do we pay for the incoming freight, but we deliver the goods to most larger customers for free if they hit minimum dollar order amounts.

What about the costs of the molds to

make the ties, frogs and other metal dies to make the track? It's not as black and white as it appears. On top of that, it's already a small market, about a tenth of one percent of the U.S. population that buys G-Gauge trains.

If track weighs 6 ounces, there are 2.67 sections of track made from 1 pound of the copper and zinc combination. Assuming the zinc costs the same as the copper, that makes a 1-foot section of track \$3.40 / 2.67 or \$1.27 per foot just for the metal without the screws, ties, wax and labor as well as overhead, like rent, electricity and packaging. Don't forget that the rail has to be heated and extruded, too, which is not included in the spot price for the material itself.

As I also added, there is a freight factor both in from China and out to the dealers. Don't forget there is also the local shipping costs of the brass ingots to the factory. Like gasoline two years ago, the copper was about \$1.00 per foot. We buy gasoline weekly, but track we buy once a year and didn't notice this run-up that's illogical as there is no refinery shortage in the middle.

We are not getting rich on track and our competitors will have to face the raw fact of the commodity pricing of copper and zinc.

CHINESE GOVERNMENT IMPOSES METAL EXPORT TAX

The Chinese government has imposed a metal export tax as of June 1st this year. Steel products were raised between 5-10%. Ferroalloy products, zinc and nickel ores also went up between 10-15%.

The new taxes, according to Chinese news reports, are meant to correct trade imbalances as a result of international trading partner pressure.

With many model train products

(including Aristo-Craft) being made with these metals, this latest news does not help with the already rising cost of these commodities.

Lewis Polk talks about alternative solutions for track...

Necessity is the mother of invention, so we're brainstorming ways to bring newbies in even with high commodity pricing. I did mention we're re-examining aluminum and will work harder on the Code 250 track with about half the brass or stainless used in the bulk size.

There are options of variations in hollow track or steel for battery operation where rusting and conductivity do not matter.

I do see battery operation allowing a variety of materials that are strong, but not conductive as options. We have some of the best minds in our production facility working feverishly to find options. As I said in my letter it will take some time to find an answer that will be the best of all worlds.

Due to the rapid escalation of the copper and stainless steel pricing, we did not have time to do this orderly, but perhaps belatedly, we will have a partial solution. The best choice will still be our brass or stainless track for those that can afford it. I have checked my records and LGB (trade-mark of LGB of America) charged \$8.00 per foot back in the early '70s when their growth jumped exponentially. Yes, lower pricing allowed the industry to grow, but we're still lower in price per foot for the hobby some 30+ years ago.

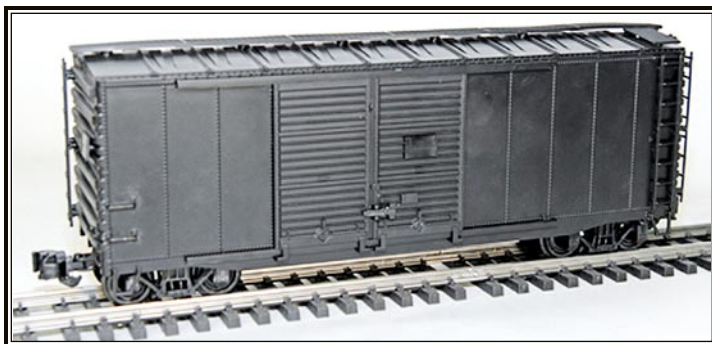

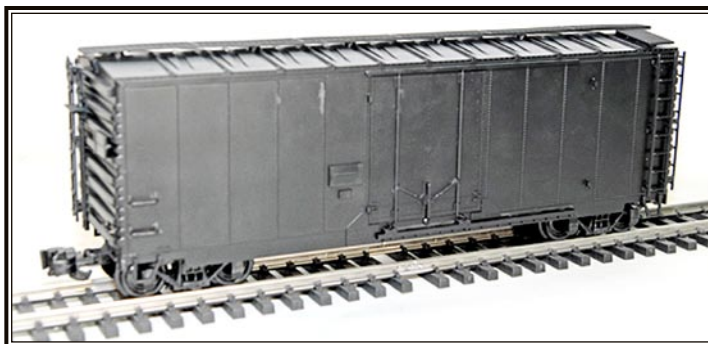

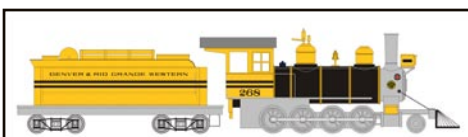

FROM THE DESK OF THE PRESIDENT...

The train business is just that, a business. At the end of the day, bills have to be paid, orders

placed, invoices printed and mailed, back orders filled, and receivings posted. Then, payroll is calculated, production is planned, and picking tickets are printed after orders are placed. On the accounting side, accounts receivable are posted, the inventory cycle is counted, statements are sent, and accounts are set up accurately along with inventory and the matching GL codes for accounting. On top of that, there is communication with all of our customers. Before computers, this took an army of people, but now computers do it better and more efficiently.

We have seen many companies in our industry go out of business because they couldn't master the complexity of computerized business and thus couldn't compete in the modern world. Polk's has been computerized since the beginning of personal computers in the '70s and in fact, had the third computer store in the country as a department in our former Fifth Avenue retail store.

Frankly, it requires a lot of discipline to maintain a competent computerized business and we

have been successful in doing so. We use a software package called TakeStock by an industry leader called Infor and it's a marvel. The programming language and database system combined is called Progress and it's a hearty enterprise-sized system used by Fortune 500 companies, too.

Not only do we use a top-grade software package, but also a service group that can join in over the Internet and fix any glitch that occurs as well as maintain it. We back up nightly to an off-site Internet service and we have a hardware service on call.

Our dealer website is fully integrated to the live database on a 24/7/365 basis so that they can look in at their status and our inventory and place orders remotely themselves. Our consumer database for parts and specials will be integrated by year's end.

All of our purchase orders are maintained by the computer system and we can see what is on back order and when the order is placed, even for already partially-filled orders. Our customers' back orders are kept in the same manner, and when merchandise is received, the back orders with picking slips are filled automatically. We're soon integrating shipping and emails along with faxed invoices when the orders are shipped.

As soon as the month ends and

bank statements are received, we can get a financial statement to see our scorecard for current results. Our statements are reviewed monthly by our accountant and we can spot problems as they occur and also look ahead to see where potential future problems are.

As I said, it's a business and the money doesn't automatically pop up in the right accounts. Maryann Polk is an experienced controller who uses the computer diligently. While business is basically checks in and checks out, doing them accurately is both a science and an art form.

Team Aristo has learned to make the computer a friend and we like to think that our computer software enhances our record of trade customer service. We're not special in doing this, but quite often the role of the computer is lost on the competency of the company you're purchasing from. Be assured that we are state of the art in this matter and it allows us to move ahead with a clear business plan.

Raising the Aristocraft FA/FB-1

Correcting Too Much Of A Good Thing

I always say there are some folks who are damned if they do and damned if they

don't. Aristo-Craft kind of falls into that mode when, with the best of intentions, they rework an older product, such as the Aristo-Craft FA/FB-1 diesel locomotive.

I am an owner of perhaps one of the larger collections of FA/FB units around. Why that is, I don't really know, except that these engineers were really the first diesels that I was exposed to as a youngster. They also bring to mind the days when steam was still king of the railroads. I was born in time to see the last ten years of the big steam on American railroads, primarily on the Norfolk & Western, who were the last to give it up. As a result, I have always had a love affair with this type of diesel, and consequently, I have also started to build a fleet of the new E8/E9s.

Background: The Aristo-Craft FA/FBs were really the first modern Class 1 type locomotive to hit the American market back in the early to mid-'80s, when Aristo-Craft first started to manufacture their line of trains. Several years ago in an article about the FA/FBs, when I queried Lewis Polk, president of



Aristo-Craft, as to the number of FA/FBs built and sold, he stated that they lost count at around 10,000. In that time, with the upgrades to the FAs over the past four or so years, I would imagine that the total number of FA/FBs made is in excess of 20,000. Not bad for a hobby that at any one time has about 60,000 participants, many of whom are into Narrow Gauge where diesels are not allowed. Then there are folks like myself who have 20 of these units, and over the years have owned as many as 28 at one time.

The first FAs were made in South Korea, and to my knowledge these are the only Aristo-Craft diesels that were ever made there. I think it was this factory's total lack of regard for quality that prompted Lewis to move production from South Korea to China. In the process, somewhere along the way, Lewis got two of the best engineers in the hobby industry, Byung Song and J.K. Kim. These two are worth a whole article by

themselves. Together they are responsible for some of the greatest innovations in both the large-scale train and R/C fields.

The move to the factory in China was a plus all the way around. Lewis set up shop with Sanda Kan, a leading train maker in the region, and is still there today. Sanda Kan is now owned by J.P. Morgan and has 12 factories that are manufacturing many of the U.S. train brands sold today. It is also one of the very few companies authorized to manufacture Disney-branded items.

The changes: Lewis has never been one to sit back and say, "Life is good. I have made some money off of this model and now I will just coast." He is continually after Mr. Song and J.K. to make it better. One of the first innovations was the ball-bearing motor block now used in all two-axle Aristo-Craft diesels. Over the past five or six years, these motor blocks have proven themselves

to be so reliable that some folks have even installed them in the competition's locomotives. I have three USA Trains GP-7s that are powered with Aristo-Craft motor blocks. With the addition of the extra weight that only these motor blocks will allow, I can now pull 38 coal hoppers with metal wheels with one GP-7.

Back about four years ago, Lewis incorporated another change in the FAs in response to criticism that they were too tall on the track: He had them lowered. This along with almost four pounds of extra weight added, new smoke units in the FAs, and the addition of etched metal screens on the sides made the FAs as close to a museum-quality model as you're going to get for the street price that these bring. At less than \$400 for a set of three, these are a fantastic buy.

Now the problem: Depending on who you talk to, these changes were either perfect or problematic. The changes made these the correct height, but then to many, these changes caused problems in the area that Aristo-Craft was most famous for, making locomotives that looked good and ran good, especially on track work that was less than perfect.

Since these latest versions came out, I have often mentioned that I had problems running the newer versions as they would often bottom out on less than perfect track work, which mine is certainly the

case (That may be the subject of another article before the summer is over).

I have received over 200 emails on this subject over the past three or so years since this change was made. At first it was just a minor inconvenience for me. However, as I changed out my old brass track for stainless steel, the problem was made even worse since I was holding off until that project was completed to do any real corrections to my track work.

Well, the arrival of four of the latest versions of the Western Maryland FAs on my railroad was the catalyst that caused me to look for a better way to fix this problem so that these units ran great on not only my layout but others as well. There is a growing following of WM fans around here and we like to get together and see how much WM we can get on one layout at a time.

The Fix: I had tried placing a washer between the motor block and the screws that hold the motor block in place. The whole object was to just raise the locomotive enough to clear any dips in the track and not totally undo the lower profile, which Aristo-Craft had invested in new mold work to correct.

Well, that worked, sort of. I let this change stay for a little over a year as I was doing other things. Then, I got back around to this a couple of weeks ago when the new West-

ern Maryland FA/FBs perked up my interest. I had been running some older units and had not even had the new WM units on the track after almost a year.

I was in the process of trying to cut some tubing to act as spacers to raise these the short distance that they needed to be raised. I then looked in a drawer where I had some plastic tubing of different sizes stored. I came across a bag of 4-56 nuts that I had purchased for another project and then never used because they were the wrong size for what I wanted to do.

Looking at these nuts, I realized that they were the right size, had a small threaded hole. They were going to add about 3/16th of an inch of height to the diesels, not enough to notice or change the coupler height. They were just big enough to fix the problem. I tried using these in one of these new FAs and it worked. Best of all, it worked without changing any structural part of the FAs. In less than two hours, I had photographed the changes and adjusted a total of 10 units to the new height.

This is one of those fixes, had I taken more time to think about it, I would have more than likely made something irreversible out of this problem and spent days doing it.

In fact it has taken me longer to write this than it did to make the changes.

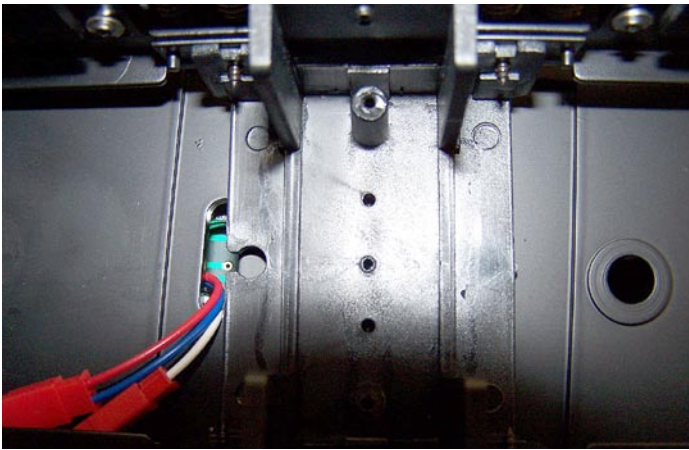
Here is How: The first thing you're going to need is a bag of small nuts. 4-56 will work, or dig through your junk bins and see what you can find. You do not want these to be too thick. The ones that I used added about 3/16th of an inch in height to the diesels.

The next step is to remove one motor block at a time, Keeping it

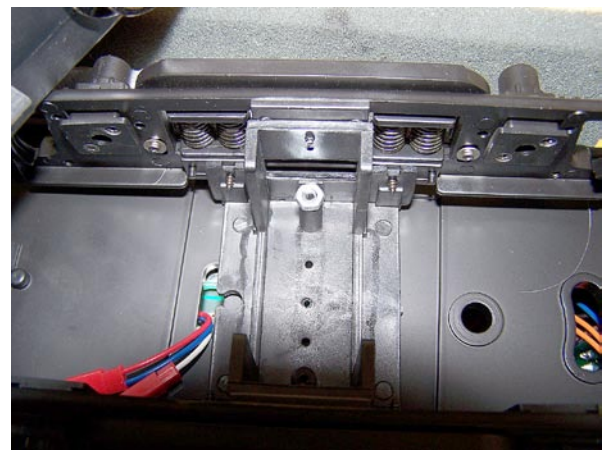
level on your workbench, place one nut over each of the pedestals that retain the motor block. Then, place the motor block back into position with the screws in place. If you have trouble keeping the screws on the pedestals and the hole in the nut is not too big, you might loosely thread the nut on the screws and then put them in place, tightening the screws. As

you can see in the photos, this is an easy fix and the height change is just enough to fix the problem and not change the great look that lowering these diesels made. It's that simple.
