NEW PAINT SCHEMES FOR 2-BAY COAL HOPPER!

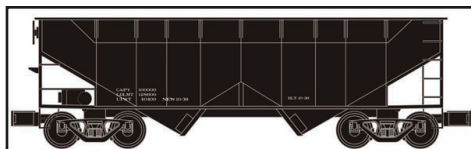
The artwork on Aristo-Craft's upcoming ART-41800 2-Bay Coal Hopper has just been completed, and we're excited to give you a first look.

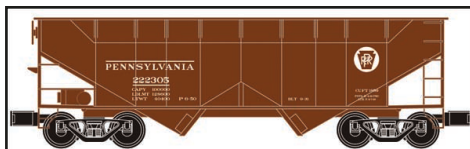
The Aristo-Craft ART-41800 2-Bay Coal Hopper Series is due out in early fall.



ART-41800 2-Bay Coal Hopper (Pre-Production Model)



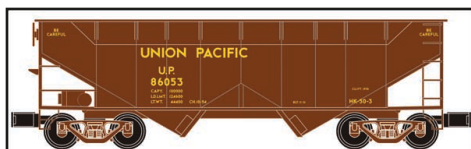

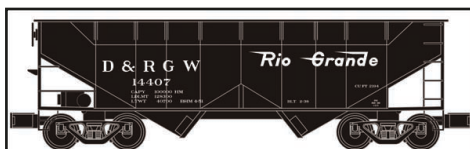

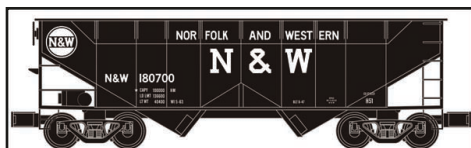

CLASS 66 REVIEWS FROM EUROPE!



The Class 66 Diesel Locomotive, manufactured in partnership with Bachmann Industries Europe Ltd., has been a big success in Europe since its release. Reviews from the British model railroading community have been very positive. We wanted to share with you two Class 66 reviews from U.K. model train magazines "Model Rail" and "British Railway Modeling." The "Model Rail" review can be found on pages 4-5. The "British Railway Modeling" review can be found on pages 6-7. Both reviews appear courtesy of their respective magazines.

Reviews

If you ever wanted proof of how Class 66s have conquered the British railway scene, consider this. For the first time ever, we now have multiple versions of a British standard gauge locomotive in 'N', 'OO' and 'G', with kits for 3mm scale and 'O' gauge and even 1:160 scale 'N' and 1:87 'HO' scale versions for the European market.

The latest of these to arrive is undoubtedly the most imposing, being built to 1:29 scale by Aristocraft Models, with assistance from Bachmann Europe.

This monster offers twin motor bogies, working directional and cab lights, a fan-assisted smoke unit and provision for installation of DCC and a sound system. A sizeable factory-fitted speaker is located under the radiator grille.

Other features include sprung, opening cab doors, etched metal grilles, sprung buffers, accurately detailed cab interiors and modular construction of electrical systems and bodysheet - a serious amount of locomotive for less than £400.

Models are available in EWS, Freightliner, GB Railfreight and DRS/WH Malcolm liveries with either original or revised headlight arrangement. The sample received for review is GBRF 66701, which is supplied with etched metal *Whitemoor* nameplates, carried by the 1:1 scale machine since May 2004.

The '66' is intended for use both on garden scale track and by 10mm:1ft/1:32 scale British Gauge 1 modellers, but there is a slight discrepancy in size for the latter and flange depth could also be a problem on finescale track. Hook and loop couplers are fitted as

standard, but alternative US style 'knuckle' couplers are provided.

The angular lines and character of the Class 66 have been captured very effectively. Dimensionally, the model is very close to the original in 1:29 scale with none of the compromises seen on recent 'G' scale diesels such as the Piko German Class 218.

Detail and decoration are excellent and the build quality of the model is what you'd expect from a company that specialises in robust outdoor railways. There's lot's of fine detail

though, including a bag of solid brass handrails, lamp brackets and air pipes. The HTCR-E bogies are very finely reproduced, even down to the restraining chains between the chassis and bogie frames.

Power comes from two motors in each bogie, driving all six axles. A panel in the roof opens up to reveal five switches controlling the power supply, motor, smoke unit and lights (on/off and day/night settings). 'Under the bonnet' there's a plethora of electronics and wiring, but still lots of space for a sound system should you

require it. A length of chunky brass 'U' channel provides the backbone of the model and gives plenty of weight for traction.

All this is accompanied by clear and comprehensive instructions to help you get 'up and running' straight away.

Garden railway fans aren't noted for their strict adherence to gauge and scale requirements, but this model brings to 'G' scale/Gauge 1 the kind of detail and decoration to which 'OO' and 'O' modellers have become accustomed. With the impending delivery of intermodal twin wagon sets and containers, the locomotives should have colourful trains to haul shortly, hopefully with more to come. The Aristocraft Class 66 represents remarkable value for money and should encourage more British modellers to venture into larger scale garden railways. **MR**

PRODUCT REVIEW

Looking for a big 'Shed'?

Bachmann, under the Aristocraft range, release the first UK model for G scale/Gauge 1.





Bachmann have released a Class 66 as their first UK ready-to-run locomotive in the Aristocraft G scale range, which is also suitable for Gauge 1. The loco is initially available in four liveries, EWS, Freightliner, Malcom Logistics and GBRf. Power is provided by two motors on each bogie, with the wheelsets running in ball bearings for maximum efficiency. Buffers are fully sprung and hook and loop couplers are factory-fitted, though knuckle couplers are included in the box. There is also bright LED directional lighting featuring both headlight styles and the cab interiors, which are detailed, are also lit. DCC and RRC ports are fitted and there is space inside the locomotive for a battery, should the track be non-powered. Also fitted is a working smoke unit, concealed beneath the roof-mounted silencer, which has an automatic cut-off to prevent it boiling dry. For DCC operation with a sound decoder, a high quality water-resistant speaker has been mounted below the roof and suitable pins on the DCC board in the loco have been left to allow easy connection. A separate detailing bag is supplied containing eight handrails and four windscreen wipers for fitting by the purchaser into preset mounting holes. Due to the size of the locomotive,

Bachmann recommend that the minimum radius it should traverse is 8' either light-engine or with a train, otherwise derailments and side clearance problems may occur. Also the deep flanges on the locomotive may cause the locomotive to run on the chairs on finescale Gauge 1 track. The model will be at model shops which stock the Aristocraft range now. Future releases will include an undecorated model and a locomotive in the livery of German railway company HGK. Bachmann plan to release a range of intermodal twin container wagons to run with this new release. For more details visit www.bachmann.co.uk.

FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Track Pricing Woes - An Update

Copper is up more than 10% to \$4.00 per pound from the point we raised our prices and the Chinese Yuan is up 12%. It doesn't look like the American Peso will stabilize anytime soon and this means we're facing a large cost problem. We will try to hold pricing down, but it really is out of our control at this time.

We will have an increase in place on track this September, which is when we will be replenishing our inventory significantly and can no longer live off of older costs. Frankly, I don't agree with our government's stance on the dollar and commodities like copper and stain-

less steel are being speculated on by huge traders that can move markets. All we can do is adjust to the conditions as they are and promise to adjust if things change the other way.

New labor laws in China and tariffs added by them to slow exports is adding to the normal woes and many companies are closing due to these forces. You may want to check out this article from Time Magazine (<http://www.time.com/time/magazine/article/0,9171,1731898,00.html>) for some insight into the market forces at play and you can see for yourselves that we are not gouging the market. In fact, our margins are shrinking, but like the old adage, we will try to make it up with volume.

We realize that LGB's track product disappeared from the marketplace at the

time we raised prices and some people thought we were taking advantage of this lack of competition. The truth is the cost of the material jumped several times in value and they would have had to raise prices too.

We check commodity prices daily, but like the price of gas you have to pay the price at the pump when you need to fill up. Let's hope sanity returns to world's commodities, but until then, we do what we have to do. As we explained in our last price list, the prices will change from delivery to delivery. Have you tried to buy copper wire at your local hardware store? Prices change from day to day and that's the world we face.

1/29th Scale & Aristo-Craft

A refresher on why Aristo-Craft chose and championed 1/29th Scale when it began making G Gauge trains in 1988: 1/29th is precisely three times the scale of H.O.'s 1/87 if you divide H.O. by 3. This was the scale that made electric trains popular in the U.S. in the first part of the 20th century with Lionel's Standard Gauge trains, Ives Trains and others. When we wanted to compete in the G Gauge world we wanted something exclusively American when the only competitor was L.G.B., which was using a meter gauge for European trains not appropriate for an American look. Lionel, etc. used a wide gauge for their 1/29th trains as stability and center of gravity was a major issue for them. Scale to gauge was not a consideration and thus they used a 2-¼ inch gauge 3 rail A.C. track system.

Our problem was that L.G.B. (a trademark of Marklin and LGB of USA) had sold millions of miles of 1 gauge track and it wasn't viable marketwise to try

to introduce a new gauge. Aristo-Craft was dependent on the installed base of the L.G.B. layouts already established in both Europe and the U.S. Nat Polk (our founder along with Irwin Polk) influenced the marketability of using 1 gauge track, noting that in England that 98% of sales in the OO scale market were different in about the same ratio as our 1/29th scale on 1 gauge track would be. If OO was a huge hit in England running on H.O.. gauged track, Nat felt it would not deter the market in the U.S. if our product was precise and constant to 1.29th scale.

20 years later, Nat Polk was proven right and Aristo-Craft has made a success of their chosen scale in the market place. Not only that, Aristo-Craft has sold millions of miles of track in the 20 intervening years and confirms why Nat was a pioneer leader in the train marketplace in America.

Consistency of scale and fidelity to scale

has been our hallmark, yet the value for dollar spent is still amongst the industry's best.

We still maintain that Lionel knew what the wow factor was in choosing this size and while a certain small percentage of people are scale only observant, the vast majority of G Gaugers just want to have fun. We contend that our trains look authentic and run better than most with our patented gearboxes and that the market is large enough to cater to all factions.

Sound and Aristo-Craft Trains

Sound is frankly a black art that only a handful of engineers can successfully reproduce in digital format. It's not just a recording, but the sounds are saved in a several second wave format and then repeated on a cyclical basis. Also, bell, whistles and chuffs must be cycled in at the correct times and be triggered in a timely manner.

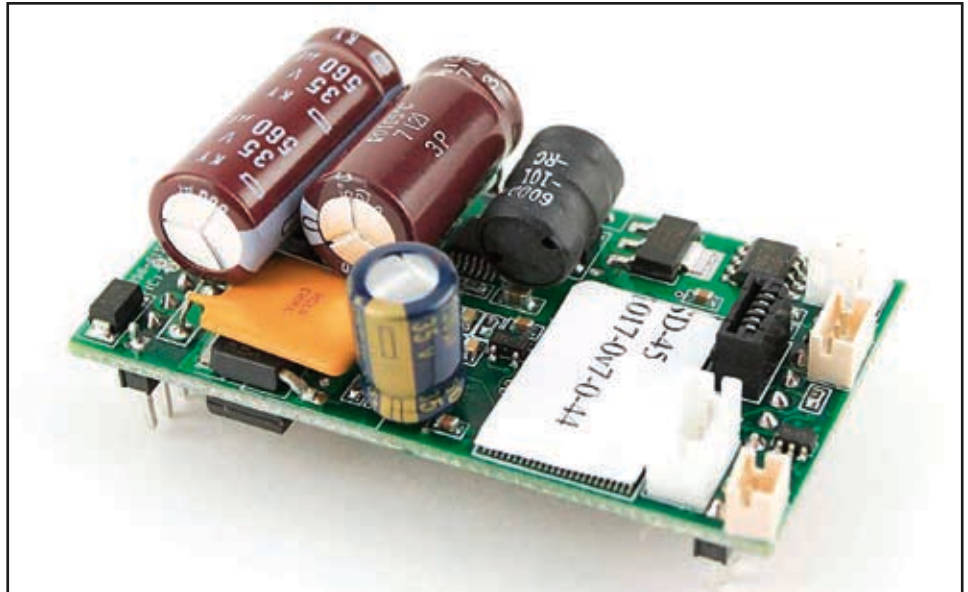
It's not pure electronics and an audiophile trained in computer chip technology is the only person that can do this. There are several wonderful sound companies available for G gauge trains and there are two that are distributed by Aristo-Craft.

The first is Q.S.I., and they have made a board that is plug and play with most of our locomotives. This board simply plugs into the port we have built into all of our locomotives for the past 10 years or so and allows for exquisite sounds in addition to control of your trains by D.C.C. or our upcoming 2.4 Ghz radio control system. Simple is better and this very sophisticated sound/control system is simple to install and use as possible. The port is a standard used by the NMRA makers of the DCC systems in H.O. and though it may evolve, we will keep the backwards functions available to all users.

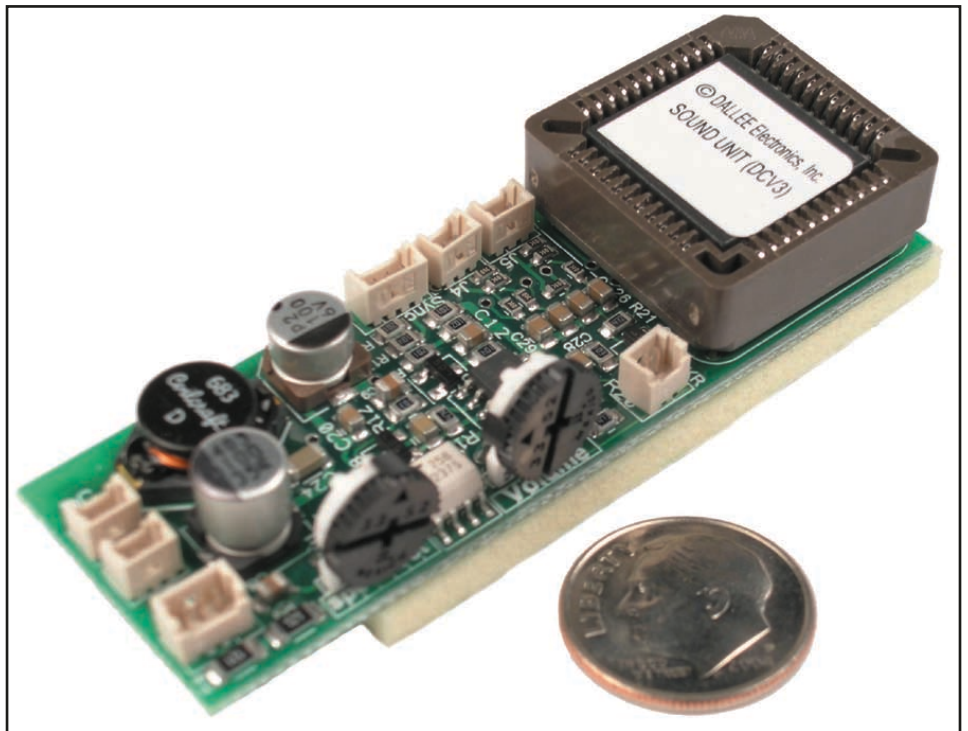
Sound brings realism to your trains and along with smoke are the two most interesting operating features to the general public as well as hobbyists about model trains. Couple this with train control locomotive by locomotive and you have a challenging and esthetically correct operation of your trains.

Not everyone is willing to spend the extra dollars for this capability, so we also carry Dallee sound that is at a similar level, yet does not have the plug and play ability, nor the train control features coupled to the sound features.

Both systems provide realistic sound, so we offer a choice according to the level of controls you wish to use. This is an exciting add-on feature to our

locomotives and has technology that is as advanced as any in the model train industry.

Aristo-Craft does not provide these in their engines, but many dealers will install these sounds for you. If you have a few technical skills of your own, you should

be able to follow the instructions and complete installation on your own.

Please check our catalog and production lists for the style numbers shown and ask your dealer of choice to help you with the installation of these sounds.
