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The Story Behind Aristo-Craft's New DVD

Cameras, lights, and microphones are not an everyday occurrence at the offices of Aristo-Craft Trains. However, that recently changed with Aristo-Craft's first foray into multimedia production, a DVD called "How Model Trains Are Made" (ART-90010). The 35-minute DVD lets viewers follow along with Lewis Polk and Scott Polk as they travel across the world to China to visit Aristo-Craft's factory, Sanda Kan.

Another Polk family member, Jonathan Polk, is behind this new video endeavor. Jonathan is the advertising designer for Aristo-Craft, as well as being an editor for television and film. "When I approached Lewis about doing a DVD, I had a totally different idea in mind," said Jonathan, "But Lewis said, 'Let's do a video about the train factory itself and how the trains are made.'"

For Lewis Polk, creating a DVD about the manufacturing process has been a longstanding desire. However, it's only been in the last few years that the technology has been available for anyone to use. The increasing power and decreasing

price of video cameras, video gear, and editing software essentially made that desire a reality to go ahead with the project.

The concept for the movie was a unique one: How do we pare down the lengthy time it takes to develop a model train from conception to completion in a way that is entertaining and informative? We "frame" it, so to

price, in terms of taking a trip to the factory itself. Lewis and Scott were recruited to be the tour guides on the trip, telling viewers everything about the production process.

Lewis came up with the idea for the video after he heard from customers wanting to know more about how model trains were created. In previous

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years, Aristo-Craft organized weeklong trips to China for groups of customers to visit the factory, but the time spent in setting up the trips was not efficient. The expensive price for customers to fly to China for a week did not help either. Thus, the idea for the DVD was born, giving many more people exposure to the factory "experience."

One of the first hurdles Jonathan faced in making the DVD was deciding on the look for the project. Documentary style was chosen so as to give viewers a realistic look behind the scenes as well as making the actual shooting easier. "I had to hand carry all of the equipment overseas, so traveling lightly was important for the project," remarked Jonathan.

From there, things started to fall into place. Filming began in Summer 2007 at the Aristo-Craft offices in Irvington, NJ, and then production moved to Hong Kong and China in October of that same year before coming back to Irvington at Christmas.

Shooting lasted a week in China, where the cameras were almost never turned off. The management at Sanda Kan gave total access to every aspect of the production process, including the mold design department, the

injection room, pad printing room, the assembly line, and testing areas.

Jonathan says that the insider's view of Sanda Kan will not just appeal to Aristo-Craft fans but all fans of model trains. "Sanda Kan not only manufactures trains for Aristo-Craft, but for many other leading train companies, too. So, we created the DVD with all types of model train fans in mind, from the diehard Aristo-Craft fan to anyone casually interested in how model trains are made."

Lewis and Scott make their debut as on-screen hosts in the video. "I was not sure how they would succeed on camera initially, but both did incredibly well, improvising on the spot without a script. That was the biggest surprise for me personally out of this trip," commented Jonathan.

Of special interest to viewers will be the section on manufacturing track. Aristo-Craft track is produced outside

of Sanda Kan at another location. The track-making process hasn't been shown before, and will be seen here for the first time.

After a week in China, filming was done and everyone headed home.

The video is narrated by Melissa Rafferty, one of the editors for the Aristo-Craft "Insider." In looking for someone to balance out the work done by Lewis and Scott, a strong female presence was needed; Melissa fit the bill perfectly. "Lewis is a big believer in using the talent that you have in-house, and that worked out wonderfully here. Even though it is her first time as a narrator, Melissa blew us all away. Let's hope she doesn't decide to change her career and leave us!"

With post-production wrapping up soon, Jonathan is looking forward to releasing the DVD. "We've been receiving very positive comments so far. There is something for everyone in it," said Jonathan. "Now, we just have to get it done and get it into everyone's hands!"

Look for the new DVD, "How Model Trains Are Made" (ART-90010) by the end of the year!

The economy is in serious trouble and JJ Productions is going to skip their SELSTS and MWLSTS in 2009 and we will see what happens going forward. The shows are for-profit shows and haven't attracted enough of a following to be so. Frankly, we are not able to build for the future at this juncture of the economy and have decided to hold a second show in York in the Fall of 2009 instead of the two more distant shows.

Harry Hartman has done a wonderful job putting on delightful shows and we have backed the shows financially in spite of losses. Frankly, we have no confidence in the economy's success next year and will no longer undertake a losing venture until the economy is back on its feet.

The York show is currently successful and like the TCA that holds the show twice a year in the Spring and Fall, we will attempt a second show at York. Will it work? We don't know, but we feel we need to give our vendors a better chance to make a profit than the other two shows have done.

Therefore, we have booked the same hall in York for October 22-24, 2009, instead of continuing with the other two shows in Perry and Springfield. We regret this choice as we have had tremendous support from the local clubs in both venues and the shows have been terrific if under attended. We need to fill a demand and the demand has not been sufficient enough to continue onward.

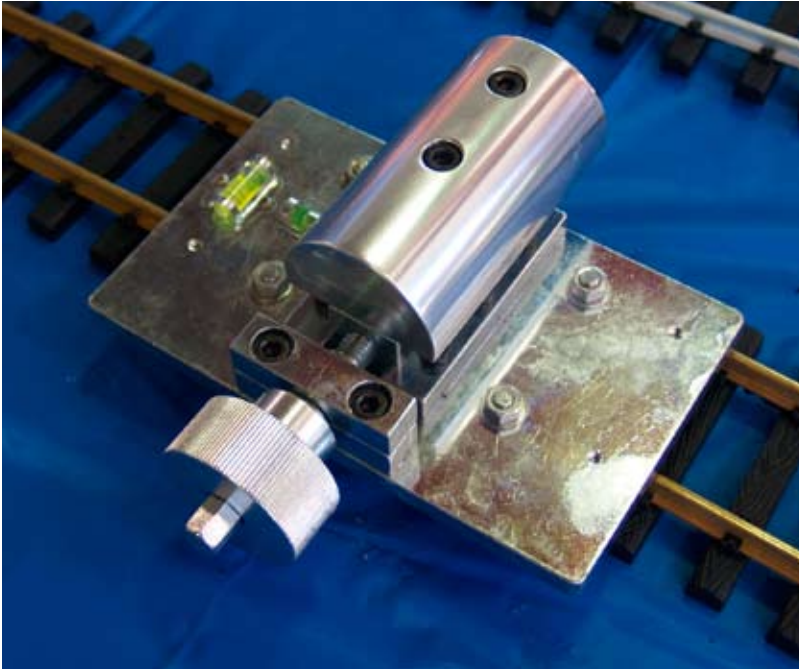

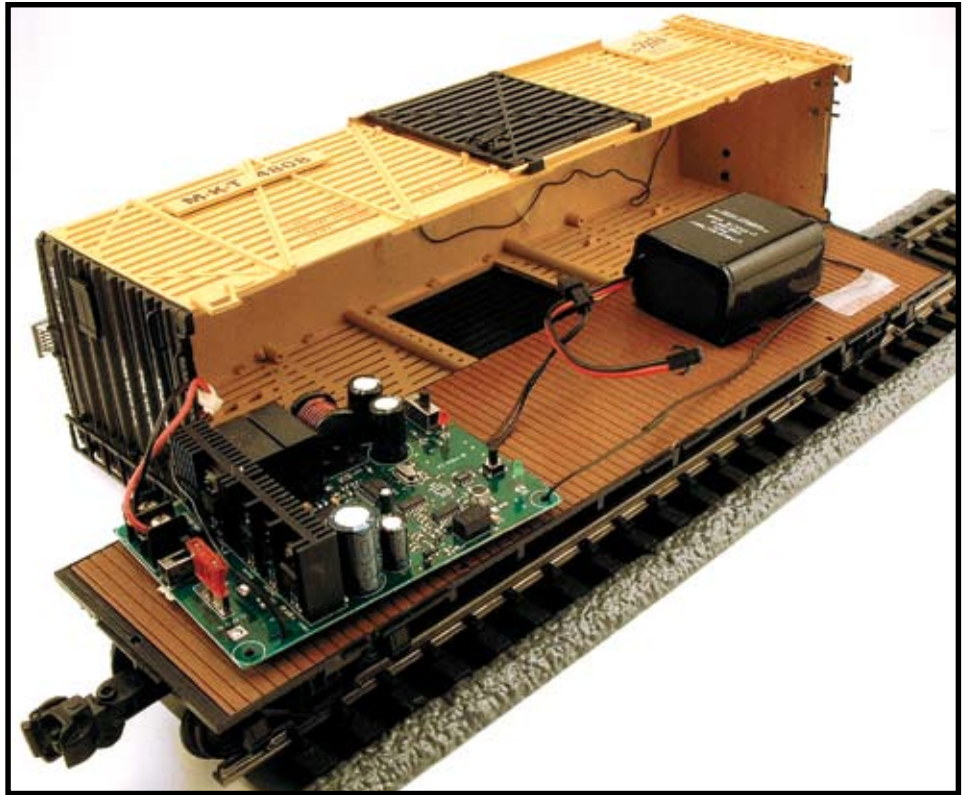
WHY HASN'T G GAUGE RAILROADING REACHED ITS POTENTIAL?**by Lewis Polk**

Gardening is America's number one hobby and blending it with motion in the garden with model trains seems to be an ideal partnership.

Having trains operate in natural environments like the real ones do is the best way to run trains and that was the reason G Gauge trains have sparked so many people's interest. Instead of modeling a specific scene on a specific day in history on a carefully modeled table diorama, you model in a real world outdoor scene and cope with nature as the real trains do. Of course, scale is a matter of perspective out of doors as a blade of grass and all the rest of nature's flower and fauna can only be approximated to scale; whereas the indoor modeler can control all aspects of scale.

Operationally, the cleanliness of tracks and the continuity of power on a roadbed that is influenced by nature's whims during season changes and rains has proven to be a challenge. Digging trenches that are filled with gravel approximates the real world condition, but still takes a lot of maintenance time that is a business job for the railroads and a chore for the hobbyist.

I admire those with the fortitude to maintain their outdoor railroads properly, but we're competing for the hobbyists' time as much as their ability and therein lies the rub. Not

enough of us have the time to tackle the maintenance adequately and thus running well becomes problematic. Disheartening to some and a challenge at best to the rest. Many people rise to the challenge well, but many people minimize their running time or give up entirely. To make the G Gauge hobby grow we need to simplify the process of operation and bring more fun time to the hobby.

Aristo-Craft Trains, as one of the leading makers of G Gauge, has formulated a program to simplify the operation. The standard operation of trains with electricity from power packs has been a transplant from the indoor mode and works for many people. However, the maintenance factor required to provide operation

is compromised by the sparking of the power where the wheels meet the track and G Gauge requires far more amperage and current than does the smaller gauges. This sparking brings a carbon blackening to the wheels requiring constant cleaning and the same for the track. The carbon black problem is in addition to the normal oxidation of track and the wheel cleaning job is the most ignored aspect of the hobby.

So, what is Aristo-Craft's answer? To grow the hobby using battery power and radio controlled operation of outdoor trains. What does this do to help? It simplifies the maintenance process as the wheel condition no longer matters, nor does the

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cleanliness of the track. The power goes directly from the battery to the motor and the variations of power for speed and direction are handled by the radio control system. We don't ask the many of you operating on track power to change if you have mastered the technique, but we think we can get many more people into the hobby if the operation and maintenance took far less time than it currently does.

Our Train Engineer with a trailing car including radio and battery are a good solution. Costs are minimized, because you need only one car per consist instead of an R/C unit in each locomotive. We have already included plug-'n-play wires on most of our locos, and in 2009, no locos will be produced without them.

We have also introduced a range of batteries to meet all needs. Our Li-on batteries are a success, though pricey. They are great for using inside tenders or locos and in trailing cars. They require special circuitry to prevent negative charges and we have built the circuitry into the packs and their small size and high power are a natural for our trains. We have also brought in some N_CaD and Nickel Metal Hydride packs as they are simpler and less expensive not requiring the circuit boards.

All of these packs are capable of running trains longer than the recharge time required to keep a spare pack on charge. Therefore, you can have continuous running, just by changing the batteries that takes only a few seconds to do. We have run trains on a single charge over 6 hours here on our

test tracks and that's with a normal consist of trains.

Therefore, we've eliminated running wires underground to power the track, use of rail clamps to secure power, the need to clean locomotive wheels regularly and the need to spend an hour or two cleaning track in advance of running each day.

Secondly, I thought about my friend, Chuck, who built a shed on his layout and runs his trains through that building. It allows him to store his trains at the point of the layout and add cars and consists at will at the origination point. Chuck has trap doors on the shed that can be closed when not running to keep critters out and I'm going to talk him into having some of our in-line re-railers to conveniently load locos and cars onto the track and to put them back on the track if a wheel should jump the track during the operation of his trains. This is serious fun without the labor of transporting your trains back indoors at the end of the day.

Most gardeners have a tool shed out in the garden and there's no reason for

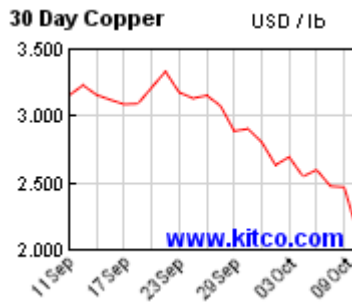
garden railroaders not to do the same to store their trains close at hand for operation. There are a host of garden sheds available at the larger garden shops and Chuck actually copied the Silverton Station from a Pola kit to make his station house. I'm sure most of you have seen shed builders on the highways who make childrens' play gyms, gazebos and play houses who certainly can provide a "maintenance shed" for you to use as the center of your layout. Paul Busse, who makes public displays of trains, always has hidden maintenance sheds to service the trains out of site of the public and we should follow his lead in this manner to increase the enjoyment of running our trains.

Once again, our point is not to change the way anyone currently runs their trains, but to suggest we can bring more newbies into the hobby with battery and radio control operation as the preferred methodology of running trains out of doors. This is just one opinion, but we will have this approach available for our trade partners to sell and hopefully attract new customers.



Track Prices Coming Down

At the time we priced track for our 2009 price list, copper was trading in the mid-\$3 range. In the last few weeks, it has dropped to the mid-\$2 range, so we are canceling the shown price increase in the 2009 price list that was based on the 15% decline of the U.S. dollar in addition to the high price of brass.



We purchase track 6 months out, so it's likely the track prices will come down later in 2009. We do not have a formula for the reduction yet, as there is not a direct correlation in pricing due to the commodity alone. There is labor, packaging and general overhead that is part of the mix in costing track, but we will nail this down shortly and let you know.

There is a lot of volatility in commodities at the moment and whether it will hold is the question. We're dealing with a moving target, but it's our goal to tell you exactly where our pricing will be, according to the commodity price. We expect to confirm this via e-mail to you before December 1st.

45 Great Reasons Why You'll Love The New 2009 Train Engineer, "Revolution"**by Lewis Polk**

The newest version of the Train Engineer, called "Revolution," is in development. Many new and exciting features are in store. We will have our first production photos in an upcoming issue of the "Insider." In the meantime, here are 45 great reasons why you'll love the "Revolution."



1. First of all, the signal is digitally transmitted through the air at a high speed directly to the locomotive decoder or accessory receiver instead of through the track work. Potential signal loss from dirty track is not an issue, so the transmission of the signal is solid, never intermittent.
2. Electrically, the track is used as a source of power only, not as a signal carrier. The power pack is set to full power and the R/C device takes over the control of speed and direction. Optionally, battery power can be used eliminating track power altogether.
3. The speed of the R/F (radio/frequency) transmission is several hundreds of times faster than the speed of a carrier signal through a track system and allows for an equally rapid response feedback from the bi-directional receiver-decoder transponder.
4. No power converter base station or signal booster is required, keeping costs down as well as allowing for direct control of up to 50 locomotives or accessories.
5. The signal is at 2.4 GHz, which is so far higher a frequency than the electrical noise made by the locomotive motors that they do not affect the performance of the radio signal. Whether or not there are noise suppressors on the motor, the radio performs glitch-free. That's why all model R/C airplanes and cars have gone to 2.4 GHz and now we are doing trains that way.
6. You do not need CVs or other codes to memorize as all functions are available on the screen in simple English text. The manual is for familiarization and not something you need to take a course on.
7. Long trails of wiring to the track are not necessary as all transmission is through the air. Have you ever looked at the miles of wiring under a DCC HO layout?
8. All programming is done in the transmitter and then down-linked to the receiver/decoder. This means you can wirelessly link as many locos together in a consist as you want and each will act in unison with others chosen or totally independent of each other.
9. You can have multiple group codes, so your "all stop" command will only affect all locos in your group or selectively all trains operating on the layout.
10. No program memory loss will occur when the battery is removed.
11. Rechargeable and removable batteries in the transmitter.
12. 5 Amp continuous power capabilities and 8 Amp peak power in the receiver.
13. 10 Amp continuous power in an optional base station style with a 12 amp peak.
14. You can control all your locos and accessories from a single handheld unit.
15. The ergonomic design lets you operate the train with one hand, though two hands are required for setup.
16. Our handheld looks like a portable phone and operates in a familiar manner. Input data information is done like phone texting using the handheld's keyboard.
17. No cooling fan is required for the components as the heat sinks are sufficient to keep the new high-grade components cool.
18. There is sufficient memory for up to 50 trains or accessories without adding additional memory.
19. There will be a 10 function accessory serial board for sounds or other triggers and it can be daisy-chained for an unlimited amount of functions.
20. There will be a switch machine receiver box for operating up to 5

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switches simultaneously.

21. All selections are available on the LCD backlit graphic screen, without the need to consult a manual for codes once you are familiar with the overall capabilities of the unit.
22. All settings are in understandable screen selection option choices without requiring the memorizing of code or value choices.
23. Our system will keep sending the last command if track power is interrupted due to shorts or dirty track conditions and will maintain the last signal until a new code is received.
24. No special programming track section is required as the linking process transmits to the loco or accessory directly to the decoder.
25. The decoder and the receiver are in one small package that is plug-and-play with many locomotives. Other G Gauge locomotives can be wired to the receiver and decoder easily. General instructions are provided.
26. Outputs for bell, whistle or horn, smoke and lights are already on the receiver board.
27. Operates either with onboard battery or track power. The track power version has a linear or pulse width selection, though the onboard is pulse width only.
28. Has a backlit screen for night operation or in low light areas.
29. No tether wire from the transmitter to the track is required.
30. Range is beyond the line of sight of any locomotive on any size layout. The signals will travel through walls and around partitions, as it's a true radio signal, not an infrared one. Typically, 300' indoors and 500' outdoors is the minimum range to be expected and can be more depending on the environment.
31. 2.4 GHz is an international ISM (Industrial, Medical and Manufacturing) standard that can be run with the same commands and equipment anywhere in the world without a license.
32. The chance of two system units being on the same frequency is one in several million, so any number of people can operate simultaneously at a club.
33. Speed settings are programmable up to 1,024 steps for incremental control beyond anything conceived in DCC and allows for totally prototypical switching techniques.
34. Can run AC or DC powered trains.
35. The system will be available in English, French, Spanish and German languages.
36. In our system you can copy one entire locomotive's settings to another and change names only to save setup time and to be sure that MUed locomotives are synchronized in all settings.
37. Top speed setting percentages are possible to set, so you can keep speeds prototypical.
38. Momentum and reverse delay settings are easily settable on the screen display by percentages, not codes.
39. Our switch accessory board can run up to 5 switch machines simultaneously and instantaneously from any distance wirelessly.
40. 50 locos or accessories can be easily expanded to 999 with the addition of a plug-in memory chip. To be available at a later date.
41. All installation on Aristo-Craft locos are typically plug and play only, so that no specialist installation work is required if the locos are provided with a port as most Aristo-Craft locos are and most HO locomotives are.
42. This is the future direction for Aristo-Craft and this system will get our full support for the future of our company. Our last train engineer was conceived and produced more than 20 years ago and technology has changed and so now have we.
43. Made to almost zero defect standards using the highest possible components for a long and reliable product lifetime with a 5-year warranty.
44. More than 2 years in development by our own very experienced R/F trained engineer. All engineering designs done in house including all of the software programming.
45. Finally, the use of the "Revolution" Train Engineer is user friendly, logical, intuitive and does not require any computer or technical expertise. If you can use a cellular phone, you can run your trains successfully with the Train Engineer.

1/29TH SCALE REASONING

We frequently get asked about our choice of producing models in 1:29 scale. If you are new to the hobby, then this article will help explain our reasoning.

In 1986-7 we were looking to make a G Gauge item that was pure Americana, not the meter gauge of LGB's line (LGB is a trademark of Marklin). Nat Polk, an old time member of the TCA and formerly the Ives club knew that Lionel's Standard Gauge trains were 1/29 and they literally dominated the American market in the first part of the 20th Century. Lionel was made in Irvington, NJ where Nat lived, as did Dorfan, and he had a close relationship with the Lionel management. Nat always noted the wow factor at the TCA shows where Lionel tinplate standard gauge sold in the tens of thousands of dollars and ran on a non-scale wide track to counter the higher center of gravity.

Nat was also close to the Lines Brothers in England and noted that OO dominated there running on H.O. track and had most of the market as it does today. Yes, there are H.O. buffs in England, but they represent perhaps 5% of the market. People in England wanted preciseness of scale in their models, but it wasn't important that the gauge was slightly different. This is true today in O Gauge, where there is a small element of 1/48 scale operators, but O Gauge was flourishing without a scale that matched their gauge.

Nat had sold LGB trains for almost 20 years before we entered the market and knew how many miles of 45mm track was sold. Nat was a great marketer and knew that if we produced a train that did not run on 45 mm track we would lock out the 20 years of hobbyists who have invested in those miles of rail. Nat, of course was proven right as USA Trains (a copyright of Charles Ro) and now Bachmann Europe (a copyright of Ka-

dar) have invested in and produced 1/29th scale product.

The fact is that $1/29 \times 3 = 1/87$ or the H.O. scale and thus is what G Gauge should have been if developed in the U.S. While many people care about the gauge to scale difference, most care about the fidelity of scale within the models and not the gauge of the track. After all, the gauge of 4'8 1/2" came from the Romans and the size of the carriages needed to match their famous roads, not because it was a scientific size. Frankly, railroad used many different gauges until interoperability logic won the day.

The larger size of 1/29th just looks better, especially out of doors, and the tremendous investment of manufacturers in the scale have outweighed the smaller 1/32 scale product. Nat predicted the famous American size and look of 1/29th scale would win the day and he has been proven right. The market place has spoken and there will always be competition to fill the market for all tastes, but 1/29 is the largest production base in G standard era trains.

We might say the same thing about Code 332 rail that is far more forgiving out of doors where Mother Nature affects the

roadbed of the track. Keeping the trains on the track is far more urgent than the correctness of scale of the rail. The H.O. people that work on table tops cannot understand that reality, but anyone that runs out of doors gets it.

G Gauge is a fun gauge as the moment you are out of doors you can't control the size of the blades of grass and can only approximate the scale of the flowers and trees on the layout.

Relax and enjoy as the vast majority of G Gaugers do and let the fretters wonder why their misplaced logic has not won the day. The market place rules, not the forums and chat rooms. The public is smart enough to figure out what they like and want to enjoy their hobby. Some say it's too serious to ignore and Nat knew that within limits both sides were right. Aristo-Craft continues to make exact scale models and sell it on 45mm track and has done so for 20 years now.

Would we do the same thing again if we were starting over? Absolutely!

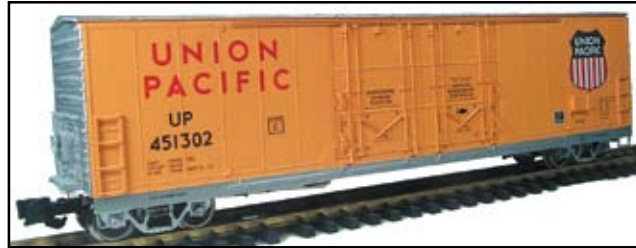
