# The Revolution: Choosing RCC over DCC

We wanted to make an impact on the model train industry with the Revolution Train Engineer. Doing another DCC (Digital Command Control) implementation

would not do it for us. Taking a slice of an already crowded pie would not help make the pie bigger. DCC is a good control method born during the earlier days of the computer on a chip era and the first implementations by Mr. Lenz were brilliant. It did bring realistic individual control to model trains. The unification of the code by the NMRA (National Model Railroad Association) was another brilliant step in making this a universal system for model railroaders.

The NMRA committee that did the joint approvals is comprised of talented engineers, but we believed that the human interface was neglected in favor of maximizing the capabilities of control. As a result, DCC manufacturers began adding competitive features that were aggressively harder to understand unless you purchased far more expensive base stations.

Wireless technology by radio signal has dominated the face of technology over the past decade with chips that were increasingly powerful and featured positive 2-way interaction between transmitter and receiver. The human interface has also improved. We felt that we could make a system far faster with very quick response to commands by air, latency-free, and with a graphic, backlit, LCD screen. Those features would make the use of the system easy to understand and yet still give the kind of motor control that DCC had brought to the marketplace. Hence, the Revolution Train Engineer was born.

We could have slowed the signal down to interface with the DCC committee's standard coding, but we would not have then be able to bring the benefits of the newer technolo-

gies to a concept where the decoder was the center of operation.

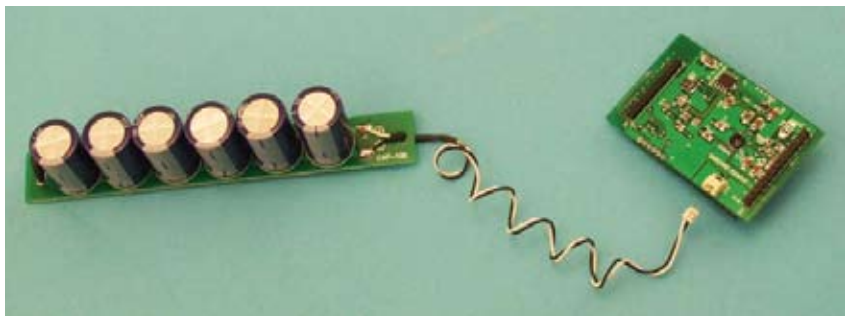
Then came the old 80-20 rule, which meant we could get up to 80% of the satisfaction of use with the features we included and add 20% to attempt to garner more of the market that supported DCC. Now there are little if any features in DCC that couldn't be duplicated in our easier-to-use graphic format, but how many would transfer their loyalty to a newer technology? So, we put in the 80% of control that most people wanted and could absorb quickly without over-complicating the choices our system used. Once we develop a base of satisfied users, it's possible for us to add the last 20% to garner 20% more business, but it's a step-by-step process. Competition, being what it is, means we will have other systems doing what we do and having to add more features to gain market share

from us. Will we match or exceed them in a feature war? At this time it is undecided, but we certainly have a headstart if we want to.

Another thing we did was use components that were mil-spec to the best available, regardless of cost. We wanted to be free of temperature problems, so we used high-grade mosfets and we chose a viewing screen that cost more than the rest of the transmitter parts combined. Our push-button keys had to have a million-use lifetime capability and match mobile phone quality. When was the last time you had a mechanical problem with a mobile phone?

We will make a H.O. version of the Revolution in the future once the kind of super-close surface mount technology needed is readily available to get all the parts to fit the H.O. size limitations. Don't forget that we have

## Close-Up: CRE57076 Capacitor Board

Available on May 5th for the Revolution Train Engineer is the CRE57076 Capacitor Board. This device plugs directly into a socket on the Revolution receiver (CRE57002) and supplies current to provide constant voltage over dirty track or poor connectivity in track layouts. It can also be used in lighting in passenger cars that have a tendency to flicker over dirty track.

The CRE57076 Board is designed mainly for those who will use the Revolution with track power. Our tests have compared operation on dirty track and this is a great solution by smoothing out operation on bad spots. While many are able to keep their track in perfect condition, the reality of nature will cause many others problems.

The CRE57076 Capacitor Board retails for \$25.00.

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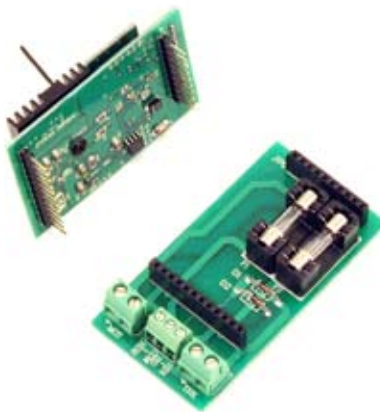
the equivalent of a decoder and a receiver all on one board and the H.O. size will be even more of a challenge than our G Gauge model. However, the lower amperages and the need for less mosfets and heat sinking will help miniaturize what we're already doing.

Our vision is to power all trains by battery technology, which has taken great strides forward in the last decade. The model airplane, car and boat people have been doing this forever, but their needs are more complicated by the great bursts of power for short periods. Model trains need long run times. Lithium Polymer batteries can be provided even for trailing power box cars that give many hours of running times instead of the dozen minutes used in model planes. The slow charging of the batteries extends their life usage and minimizes safety requirements that the fast charging techniques incur. Our selected battery for H.O. scale will be 11.1V and 800 m.a., but the consumer can use what they wish or parallel or serial versions of the same depending on the amount of room available. We have a 19v 2.8 AMP NiMh (Nickel Metal Hydride) version for G Gauge already on the market as well as Y parallel and serial plugs to double your power or running time.

Another reason for on-board battery power in any gauge is the serious problem of pitted or dirty wheels from the "carbon black" generated on the track by high power going from the rails to the wheels. This is the single biggest problem in operation of track-powered trains, in our opinion. Direct to the motor power from onboard batteries eliminates this complication and allows trains to operate continually with optimum current without wheel and track involvement. Perhaps stainless steel wheels could also cure this problem, but the price of stainless steel is exorbitant and they have to be expensively CNC (Computer Numerical Control) cut to bring the best characteristics and roundness to the modeler. Onboard power also makes up for weakened fish plates "rail joiners" and any other track continuity problems that often occur.

Wireless technology has improved dramatically over the past decade by increasingly featured chips designed for two-way interac-

The CRE57077 Non Plug-N'-Play board is for use with any G-scale locomotive to make it plug-n'-play with the Revolution Train Engineer.

Aristo-Craft locos are designed with this connection in mind, but other makers' engines are not, which is where this board comes in.

The board comes equipped with two 5-amp fuses. We recommend using double-sided foam or velcro tape to hold the board to the loco.

tion between transmitter and receiver. The driving force has been the computer and its modem technology as well as the mobile telephone with graphic screens. Of course, we're piggybacking on those huge technologies that brought economics of scale to our smaller industry. We spent 2 years just making the choice of the computer chip that would allow for the greatest usage of user-friendly technology and be completely hidden. We came up with a chip from Chipcon, a smallish company in Denmark, and that troubled our minds about the longevity of the technology. However, this company was so promising that T.I. (Texas Instruments) purchased them and thus the longevity issue was eased. Of course nothing in life is guaranteed, but this now became a good bet. There are a lot of competing technologies and we're sure that other chips will come along, but today this was the best choice for us. Frankly, we purchased development kits from many chipmakers and then settled on Chipcon, so it was not a shoot-from-the-hip idea. We had also previously done a 75 MHz version that suffered from motor interference and knew that a higher frequency was needed. Horizon proved this in the model field and was followed by a custom chip developed by Futaba. We used Chipcon as it had the most speed and used the least power in relation to the other tested versions. Also, it's DSS or Digital Spread Spectrum, which the 900 MHz processors in use do not have. The DSS means that two signals can be shared

as the packets are individual, but that's not true of the dial a frequency versions from others on the market. Interference between the dial types is possible and causes latency and short-range situations, so unless they are DSS they are not industrial, medical, and scientific.

The impetus for this growth has been the 2.4 GHz technology that is IMS (Industrial, Medical and Scientific) approved, license free, and has open signals, which means we can operate openly anywhere in the world. The model airplane people had to lobby for their 72 & 75 MHz frequency allotments and implement a central system of flight frequencies, so that other people could not step on their usage of the allotted frequency at the same time. 2.4 GHz is sent with an identifier packer that only a "linked or bound" receiver will accept and thus any interference possibilities are greatly lessened to a chance in a million. This gives a glitch free performance not possible on the lower shared frequencies and the signals are also impervious to the generated motor electrical noises from the power or fan motors used in model trains. Yes, you can partially suppress those electrical noises, but at different speeds, the same electrical noises will still glitch the frequency or shorten the range. Also, we have put the pulse width signals at a frequency above human hearing and yet still give you plenty of power without any motor humming. Our T.I.

(Texas Instruments) chip was the most stable we could find to correct those problems, though also the most expensive. Remember, we need two of these expensive chips, one for the transmitter and one for the receiver in each system. Also, we're not contracting for a million or more over a year as do the mobile phone and modem people are able to do, so our pricing level is high. Nonetheless, nothing but the best would do for our far-reaching conceptualization of the train control market. Please note that both the TX and RX are FCC approved, so no shortcuts were taken.

Model trains are a hobby, not an income stream for business usage. Therefore they are the last dollar spent by the hobbyist, not the first to make their business endeavors more profitable. We are struggling for their time as well as their dollar, so a manual of 40 pages graphically illustrated, not a textbook, meant they could master the control of their trains in their leisure time. Yes, people that have technical skills from their day job take to DCC like ducks to water, but the kind of people that love to replicate history in their own Lilliputian world don't want to devote extra time to their leisure hobby to master the scientific approach that it requires to make full use of the CVs (Configuration Variable) available in DCC. The fact that they have gateway CVs leading to other CVs and programs to calculate CV values is logical to technical people but can be off-putting to the rest. Competition between the hardware makers is so intense that train manufacturers have to put out the correct CV choices for the specific locomotive they are making to stop a much higher rate of returns due to poor performances.

When a large number of signals are sent by track power from a base station on DCC to consists, each with several trains and with several people running at the same time, the signals can slow down or clash depending on the mode of the consist. Not so with the Revolution that is sending signals 1,000 times per second to each loco independently and on a network that could handle several hundred consists without degradation. We can turn off or on lights or sound on each loco, even the

last in the consist and have them reverse with directional lighting easily with our elegant consist design. You can adjust speeds for hundreds of trains simultaneously also without degradation. Our radio signals are unlimited in number without cross interference and the range is not affected by the number of people in the area or limited to a few rotary dialed frequencies.

The graphic screen choice proved to be the most difficult for us to implement, as there were no ready-made character libraries to use with this chip. We spent 6 extra months developing our own library and of course now this human interface is done and easily modified as needed. The programming was taken to mimic DCC's best characteristics of control, but at much higher transfer rate. What we did differently is to put all of the programming into the transmitter instead of the decoder and eliminated the need for a base station. The signal went out to the receiver 1,000 times per second, so there is no latency in the transmission to the receiver or back from the receiver to the transmitter. It's a radio wave, so it will go around walls, shrubbery, trees and anything else and thus it's not a line of sight only signal. Also, it's a 400' typical range, which means that if you were further away you couldn't see the trains you were controlling anyway.

A great choice for us was the selection of a multiple unit (M.U.) concept, where we created a fictional cab as the one that controls a consist of up to 6 cabs. Each cab can be individually tuned to match the others if they are of disparate capabilities and you can then M.U. up to 6 consists of them together in extreme usage cases. Any cab can be added or dropped to any consist without re-linking including pusher locomotives not in direct contact with each other.

The one area we're not currently satisfied with is the availability of sound controls without direct wiring of a pair of wires for each function. However, we're working on a single wire serial interface with a hidden ground that will allow 999 functions to trigger with a three-digit code that would

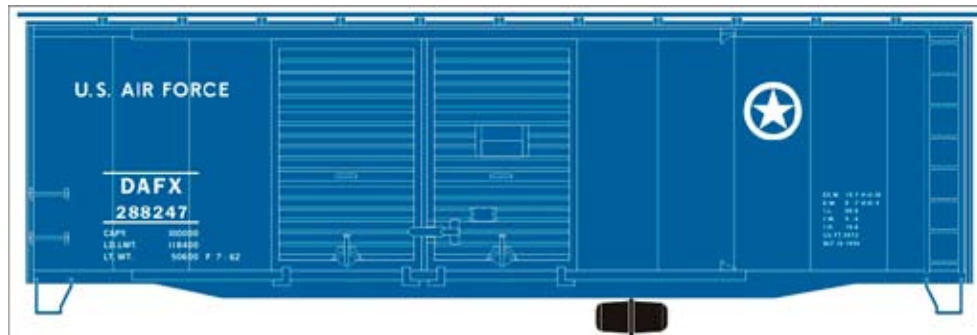
work like a computer network. Why have bundles of wires all over the place, when a single wire could accomplish the same thing. We've noticed newer automobiles now using this technique and it does simplify troubleshooting and implementations. For the programmers reading this, it does need a check digit way of confirming receipt, but instead we will simply send the signal two or three times to ensure that the message was received without extra programming. At the speed we transmit this information, it's a simpler programming technique and involves no latency problems.

We have also implemented a non-documented way of having two or more transmitters control the same cab on larger club layouts. The two-way transmission is only available to the last person to transmit to the cab, so all transmitters will not receive the speed, voltage and short information that the controlling transmitter will. This is to stop confusion, but the two or more users will need to voice communicate when turning control over to the next user. Not elegant, but it works.

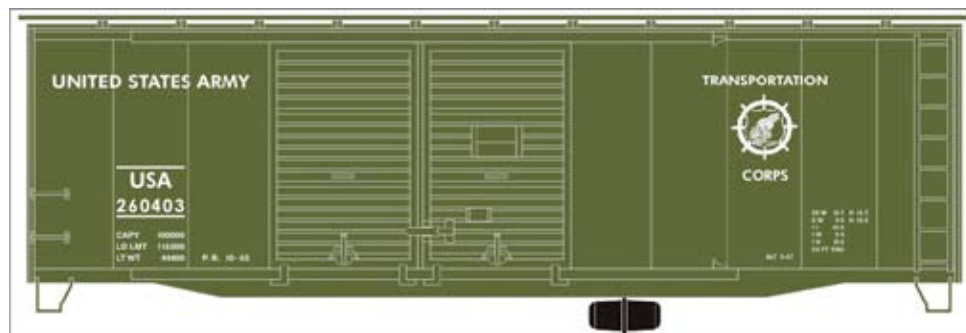
This was our perspective as we proceeded and it will take the marketplace to determine if our concept was marketable. Will we get 100% of the market? Of course not, but we did not start out with that goal. Will there be competition? Of course, but we have a head start and have had Alpha and Beta testers feeding us input for sometime now. We are not DCC experts, but our engineers did look at DCC and realized there are other choice possibilities. DCC is changing daily, so we apologize if we've incorrectly characterized some details. This doesn't mean that our system should be criticized before even being tried.

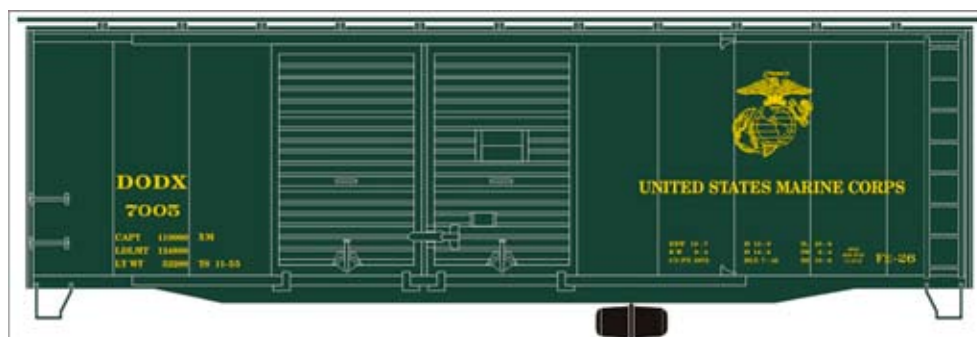

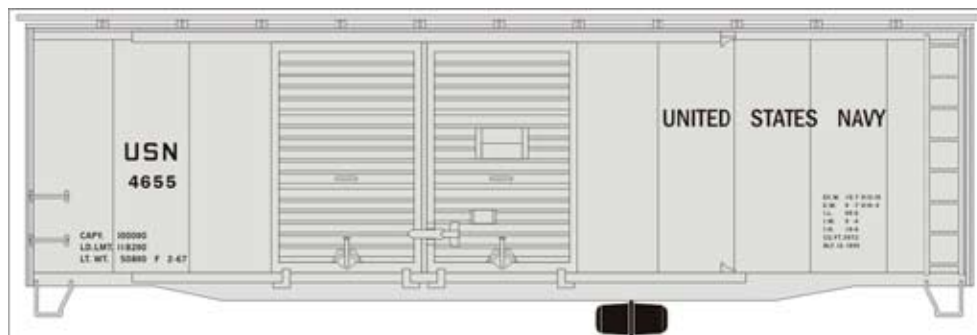

My impression of this system has not wavered since the first time that I tried it.

I am not sure what it is about this system that has me so enamored with it but I suspect it has to do with the same qualities that Apple incorporated into the iPod. The iPod is, in my opinion, the single greatest consumer product ever made. It gives me a way to enjoy the music that I love, on my terms. I own 5 iPods, my wife owns 3. Now I certainly don't need 5 iPods but I use 4 of them regularly. The secret to the iPod is the flexibility of design and elegant simplicity of the user interface.

If you wanted to control DCC sound systems, you can certainly do that but I wouldn't look back at DCC as a threat. For the majority of us who only desire to have fun running trains and blowing the horn, the smoke control, lighting direction and motor reversing are all bonuses. I could go on and on but I have to ask once more,

Do you really know just how great of a system this is? I really hope that you do, and that you take all due pride in something so well executed. The work behind the system shows.

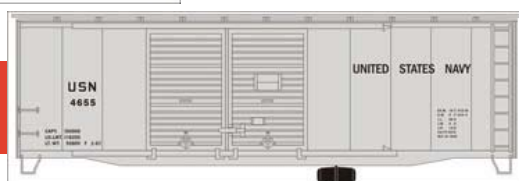

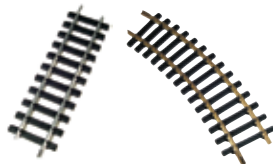
