## ***Aristo-Craft Invests Heavily For 2010***

While we did not forecast the downturn of the economy in 2009, we did plan major introductions for continued growth. Perhaps we would not have done so if we had been smart enough to forecast the bursting of the economic bubble, but as it turned out we have new product ready to deliver shortly.

The first new item is for the Revolution Train Engineer, which was the accumulation of three years of R&D effort, where we tested several systems until we found one that would do what we wanted it to do. Then we had to design a system that would work using the technology we wanted to offer the G Gauge market.

In early 2010, we will offer a stationary receiver for accessories and switches along with planned cruise control speeds and other features that we're working on.

The second is the RDC-3, which was the add-on to the RDC-1 introduced several years ago. We believe that many satisfied early purchasers would want to add on this new version to

make a double header. Also, people that missed the RDC-1 would be glad to have a second chance for one of these beauties.

We've added a fully lit interior to this RDC version and it's still made out of metal with two powered trucks. It's a train that surely maintains its collectible value many years ahead.

The third is the long-awaited PCC Trolley, which is designed as the pre-war version from early plans of the Presidents Convention Committee and mixed the first Brooklyn Trolley and Pittsburgh versions that were among the first implemented from the original design. If the first series sells well, it will be easy to do

a “standee” post war version as well, but step by step. The car features a die-cast chassis and LED lighting as well as a port to hold the Revolution board for R/C.

The fourth is the long-awaited Consolidation 2-8-0, which perhaps should have been the first steam loco we did. However, we wanted to wait until we had everything in place for our patented gearbox and smoke box, as well as a port in the tender for the Revolution receiver. It’s all ready and will be available in early 2010.

Fifth is our body-mounted Kuppler, with a drill gauge and height gauge along with spacers for height adjustments. We haven’t had anyone be able to separate the Kupplers once they were linked. We have a feeling that this will convert many of you that have held back until now to body-mounted couplers.

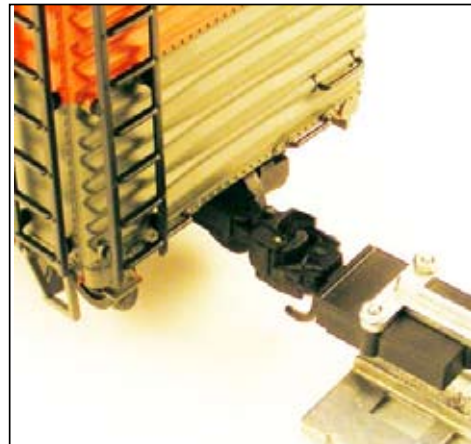
Lastly, we have working samples of the 0-4-0 live steam and the new size packaging in a metal carrying case with wheels. It’s a charmer and will work on tight radius curves for those of you that have layouts with the original small curves that were the only ones available in the early days of G Gauge modeling.

It’s been a huge effort of engineering, mold work, time and money to bring these items to market. Just one in a year would be sensational, but this grouping is a great leap forward in product in any one year for modelers.

This doesn’t mean we’re done with

new products. Later in the year, there will be the SW-1 Switcher, a 50’ box car, an all-purpose well car and other trackage like American flex track.

2009 has been a difficult year, with the slowing economy and a new owner of our production facility. We’re confident that 2010 will be a return and expansion of the Aristo-Craft G Gauge market.

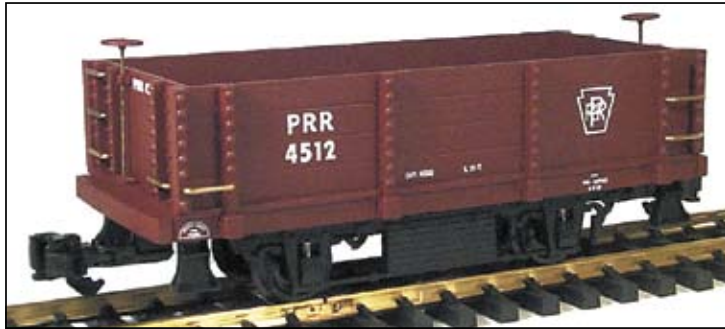

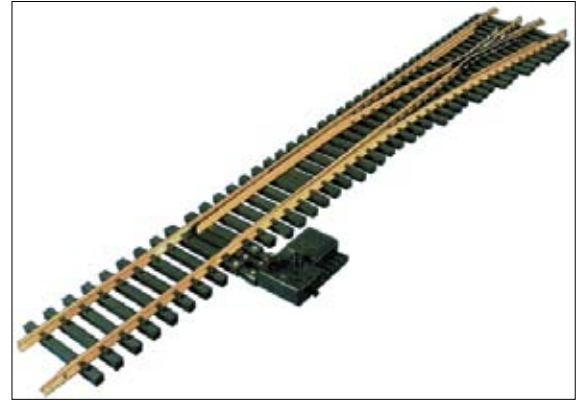
## Customer Praise for the #6 Switch

## *Revolution Train Engineer: A Follow-Up*

It has been a pleasure to introduce the Revolution to the model train market. Aristo-Craft was fortunate to have

a background in the model airplane, boat and car field and was alerted to new technology used in that field that changed the marketplace totally there.

The new technology, 2.4 GhZ frequency and the chips that evolved around it allowed for a new approach to controlling model trains. By directly sending the signal to the locomotive, we avoided the need to use less than perfectly clean track out of doors in G gauge. Aristo-Craft never expected to win 100% of the market as there were other systems already out there with a dedicated base of satisfied customers. However, we did know that we had a

great product that would appeal to both experts and newbies with it's approach to multi-train control.

However, the real test will be if new people enter the marketplace to take advantage of an easy to use visual control with all instructions in easy to read English and multiple choice style programming. Aristo-Craft wanted to expand the model train market or the exercise was not as meaningful as expected. Three years of development and experimentation went into the design process, which included how to best control your trains. This was a costly time frame, so we only spent so much effort to expand a wonderful hobby to a greater size marketplace.

What we're adding is the stationary accessory device, cruise control, better linking to sound boards and some more triggers for sound. Nothing is firm yet, but these are the items we're working on. There will be a 20 Amp base sta-

tion that can double as an on board in a trailing battery car to run multiple locos in a single consists as well. We do not intend to implement changes other than once a year, as most upgrades require returning the loco to us or visiting us at a train show where we can do the upgrade as well.

We want the Revolution to be the "coolest" train control device around and will continue to ask for input from our users to come up with needed features. This will be a grass root led development, not a top down decree of what you need.

There has been a shortage of supply due to the unprecedented demand, which is complicated by the long lead-time of the Chipcon processor that is the heart of the system. We expect to have a steady supply of the Revolution early next year, but in the mean time we are getting regular deliveries to fill much of the market demand.

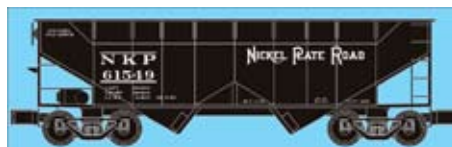

## Installing Ball Bearings in the ART-29100 Modern Freight Truck

After attending the Fall ECLSTS and purchasing my set of show cars, the Winchester & Western covered hoppers, and hearing about the new Aristo-Craft ball bearings (ART#29140) that fit these modern freight trucks without drilling, I decided to check it out and discovered that it was true. You do not have to drill out the side frames on the modern freight trucks to install the ART#29140 ball bearings. Wow, what an improvement to these trucks after having the ball bearings installed. So if you do not have ball bearings on your rolling stock, consider some of the advantages of installing ball bearings, which are less drag on your engine and/or can pull more cars on your layout. Just think how much more you can pull if you were to change over to ball bearings. One other point I would like to make about the ball bearings that I hear time and time again, "It would cost me too much to get started now to install them in all of my cars!" My answer back has always been, **"You don't have to do them all at once."** There are 10 bearings in one tube. I started out with two tubes. Then as I had a few bucks extra, I bought some more tubes. With two tubes here and four tubes there, before long, I had almost all of my cars installed with metal wheels and ball bearings. Keep in mind, four tubes will do five cars.

I have seen an article or two on how to install the ball bearings into the modern freight trucks that tell you to drill out

the trucks to accommodate the larger bearings. I don't like to drill because I am always afraid of drilling too far or at the wrong angle, so I set out in search of ball bearings that would fit these Aristo-Craft Freight Trucks without drilling. I found some bearings that were listed as exact fits, no drilling required. They are 7/32 bearings and I have found out that these bearings are now available from Aristo-Craft. They are ART#29140. This process only works on the modern freight trucks that comes with metal wheels. If you have the modern freight trucks that comes with plastic wheels, you must use the **ART# 29111D METAL WHEELS - W/O HUB**. Make sure it is 29111D as the 29111B will not work in the modern freight truck without some more modifications. When you take out the brass bushing and put the ball bearing in these side frames and install the ART-29111 B metal wheels, they bind up and you will lose the advantage of the ball bearings.

The first thing I do is remove the truck from the car that it is installed on. Then you need to take the end caps off. On one side of the truck, I take the three springs out of the truck with a small paring knife or X-Acto knife. (Sometimes I would use a small straight screwdriver) Then I pushed up on the side frame

and removed it from the bolster. Then remove the wheels. Because the brass bushing was glued into the side frame, it had to be "punched" out. I knew if I did not have something to support the rest of the side frame; I would probably break about 1/3 of them just trying to punch out the brass bushing. So I went on a search in my scrap wood pile. I found a short piece of 2X6. I took apart one of the trucks and pushed the side frame up against the edge of the 2X6 until the brake shoe stopped it. I found out that a 1/8 inch drill bit would fit inside of the bushing. So I drilled through the bushing into the 2X6. Then I took 1/2 inch drill bit and drilled that 1/8 inch

hole bigger. This allowed the bushing to drop into the hole and support the side of side frame.

Now when I go to push the bushings out of the side frames, I place the side frame face up on this block of wood and then take a 3/16 flat pin punch, place it on the brass bushing and tap it with a screwdriver handle. Not much force is needed to "punch out" the bushing. With some of the first-run modern freight trucks, they were really glued in there. You had to be careful when you punched them out, if you did not punch them out squarely, it would break off some of the side frame. This is NOT the case with the modern freight trucks being produced now. With the recent bushings, I was able to just push them out or take the punch and push them out. (You should not need the 2x6 block mentioned above.) I have also heard of individuals taking pliers and gently twisting the brass bushing out of the side frame. Whatever method you use, you must precede with caution as if you get too aggressive you could break the side frame.

Once you get the brass bushing out, I have found that all you need to install these 7/32 ball bearings is your thumbs. They will snap into place. Occasionally I will get a stubborn one and all I have to do is take the side frame, lay it on a flat surface and take the handle end of a screwdriver and tap it in place. After installing the ball bearings, I would reassemble the trucks. One trick someone taught me that really saved me some headaches was while installing the springs back into the side frames, I would take a piece of dental floss, wrap it around the spring and hold the ends in my hand. This helped keep track of the spring if it would come shooting out of the side frame. I don't know how many springs I have lost installing them into the side frame until I started using the

floss. (Thanks Ron!) After installing the one side frame, I would place the metal wheels in the side frame. I would take the other side frame and slide it over the axles and the bolster. Then, install the three springs and replace the end caps. After installing the end caps, give each axle a spin to see if you have the end caps on too tight. If they do not roll freely, pull the end caps back just a little bit and give it a spin again. They should roll very freely.

I conducted an experiment with metal wheels and then with metal wheels and ball bearings. I don't know how scientific you would consider my results but

I did it 5 times one direction with the car and then turned it around and conducted the experiment 5 more times that way and recorded the results.) I put down four 5-foot pieces of track and put a Split Jaw "E-Z Loader" on one end of the track. (If you don't have one of these items, you need to get one. They are fantastic.) I put the Winchester & Western Covered Hopper on the ramp and let it go. I placed the hopper up as far as I could on the ramp without the wheels going over the top edge. I then let go and watched it roll down the ramp onto the track. I recorded the distance the car would roll. I measured from the point the hopper would touch the rail to the coupler end when it stopped. After taking down all the distances, I would use all the lengths for each experiment to get the average. I will list the averages for each type of experiment, the longest and the shortest

distance rolled.

**Metal Wheels.** The average distance rolled was 149 inches (12 ½ feet). The longest distance rolled was 157 inches and the shortest distance was 138 inches.

**Metal Wheels with ball bearings from Aristo-Craft (ART # 29140).** What I found after installing these bearings was absolutely amazing! I tried to conduct this experiment with 4 pieces of 5 foot track and the car ran off the end of the track, so I had to add one more piece of 5 foot piece of track. I put the E-Z Loader on the one end of the track and put the

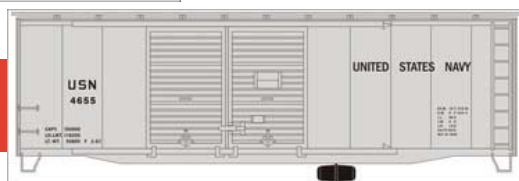
Winchester & Western Covered Hopper with ball bearing on the loader and released it. It ran and ran and ran. Wow! The average distance traveled was 242 ½ inches (20 ¼ feet). The longest distance was 249 inches and the shortest distance was 235 inches. This was a 62.8% increase over just the metal wheels.

As I told you above, how much better these trucks run after installing the ball bearings. To me, it is money well spent.

In the next issue of the INSIDER, we will take a look at installing ball bearings (ART#29411) in the standard freight truck (ART#29101).
