Looking Back at Aristo-Craft Year-By-Year

Polk's Model Craft Hobbies turns 75 years old in 2010. The Insider will be taking a look back at Polk's and Aristo-Craft all throughout the year.

1985

Aristo-Craft started making G Gauge buildings by licensing some Delton wood structure designs and converting them to plastic kits. These were successful and later converted to fully built-up and painted items.

1988

REA teamed with Aristo-Craft to make 1/29th Lionel (Lionel is a trademark of Lionel Inc. and not in any way connected to Aristo-Craft) sized standard gauge trains in 1988. Aristo-Craft had designed and started selling a track line and then merged it into their partner REA. The track had the highest percentage of copper in the market plus screwed together rail joiners.

1990

Aristo-Craft and REA parted company as REA was spending its time and fortune in litigation against another company. Aristo-Craft also moves its production from Korea to China.

1992

Aristo-Craft enters Chapter 11 due to withdrawal of credit line by bank due to \$17,000,000 lawsuit when the bank was not clear about the outcome and thus fearful.

1993

Aristo-Craft purchases most of Delton molds including C-16 Steam Loco. Nat Polk retires to Florida and Lewis and Maryann Polk take over full responsibility of the company.

1997

Aristo-Craft wins lawsuit and is entitled to keep making its track, the source of a "Trade Dress" lawsuit. The judge says we had a duty to provide competition on a non-patented item.

1998

Aristo-Craft exits Chapter 11 and pays all creditors back 100%.

1999

Lewis Polk begins East Coast Large Scale Train Show.

2000

Aristo-Craft implements ERP commercial software from Infor.

2003

Scott Polk joins company to provide 3rd generation continuity.

2008

Sanda Kan O.E.M. contractor for Aristo-Craft goes bankrupt under J.P. Morgan's ownership and supplies are affected.

2009

Kader purchases Sanda-Kan and begins to rebuild the company.

The Passing of Gilbert Rosenzweig

Gilbert Rosenzweig was my adopted big brother. I've known him all my life and worked with

him for almost 50 years. Gil, was a model airplane hobbyist as a teenager and found my father's hobby shop in Newark in the early 1930s. Gil would stop in after school and on weekends to help Nat and talk about model airplanes. Gil became a member of the famous Bamberger's Jr. Airman Club run by Irwin Polk and assisted by Nat. When Nat commingled his Newark model airplane shop with Irwin's in NYC, Gil officially started working with them in 1935.

Gil was a perfectionist in everything he did and became the go-to guy for radio control for the thousands of hobbyists in the NY area and for some 350 hobby shops that relied on Gil for the latest and greatest in model airplane technology. He made the hobby happen and it became an industry in the mid 20th century. Gil devoted his life to model airplanes, but with the introduction of the computer, bright kids like Gil gravitated away from hobby in recent times.

Gil moved into our OEM division selling motors and parts to



manufacturers. He and Irwin put Mabuchi Motors on the map in the U.S.

Mabuchi shared Gil's NY office for many formative years and then opened their own office in NYC. Gil continued to sell to smaller manufacturers Mabuchi Motors and has helped hundreds of them with his expertise.

Gil was the originator of our firm moving into hobby manufacturing. Again, his perfectionism was instrumental in making nothing but the finest of products for the hobbyists. Gil worked with us for over 75 years and devoted his entire life to the model hobby industry. Gil will be remembered

by thousands of hobbyists he has helped over the years and by his coworkers who enjoyed his company over that time.

His wife, Shirley, understood his need for perfectionism and helped him with his goals for perfectionism in his home life. Our condolences to Shirley and thanks for sharing Gil with us.

2010 Track Pricing Update



2009 Copper Pricing Chart

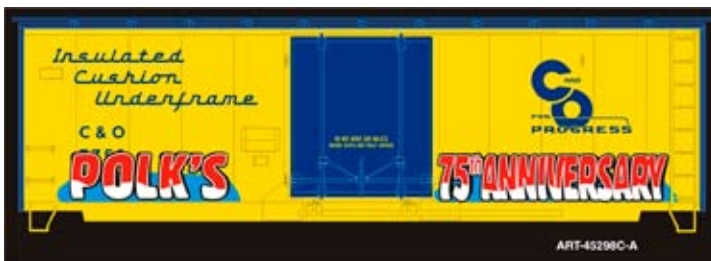
With the start of the new year, the pricing for track materials is still very volatile. Copper prices are up by 1/3 in this past year. We had rescinded an earlier increase when the price peaked in 2008 and gave "buy four, get one free" pricing all year; However, the high raw material prices have returned and we will stop the special "buy four, get one free" sale after February 28, 2010.

Yes, it has dampened sales for G Gauge, but the prices are not much different from the early LGB prices in the 70's and 80's, when the market boomed.

This is not a personal choice by Aristo-Craft, but when a product is 80% all copper the product is commoditized to a great extent by the raw materials the pricing is dictated by the world commodity pricing. We buy by the LME pricing, which is more than \$7,000 per metric ton right now. We have slightly lower priced Aluminum track, but there are tradeoffs. We can't see Copper declining in value any time soon and remember we called it the new gold last year.

There is no solution, but we are not profiting from this commodity price increase and see even lower grade rail in the future and battery operation as a viable solution.

The Neutron Express

A ride around toy train tracks inside a fusion experimental machine can reveal much about a hot gas called plasma. PPPL research staff recently mounted a neutron source on a toy train inside the National Spherical Torus Experiment (NSTX), placed it on hobby train tracks that had been installed and sent it on a three-day continuous zip around the rails. The purpose: to calibrate the neutron rate during fusion experiments.

Plasma, the fourth state of matter, is a hot gas that makes up the stars and is used as the fuel to produce fusion energy. Energy from plasma is released in the form of neutrons.

"Since NSTX plasmas emit copious amounts of fusion neutrons, scientists need an accurate measurement of the neutron rate. They use this to compare, for example, whether the simulation code has faithfully modeled the various phenomena occurring in the plasma," said PPPL physicist Doug Darrow. Darrow, along with PPPL engineer Lane Roquemore, led the project. PPPL technician Sylvester "Sly" Vinson led the assembly and installation portion. About two dozen PPPL scientific and technical, health physics, computing, management, and review staff supported the effort.

Besides helping scientists understand the physics of energetic particles, the measurement helps them develop a better predictive capability for future fusion reactors.

To perform the calibration at NSTX in early December, researchers used a Californium-252 neutron source. This particular source emits neutrons with energy similar to deuterium-deuterium fusion neutrons. Deuterium is a form of hydrogen used to fuel fusion reactions. Two deuterium atoms collide — or fuse — at hot temperatures to create energy.

To obtain the needed calibration data, the team mounted the small source on the model train and remotely ran it around five different circular tracks inside the NSTX vacuum vessel for three days. Two neutron detectors picked up the data from the exterior of the vessel.

"The tracks were set up in five different positions, which span the volume of the plasma that generates the neu-

trons," Darrow noted. "Physically it works because plasma is a big circle. Running the neutron source on a set of circular tracks is a good approximation of plasma from the point of view of the neutron detectors."

The absolute calibration measured the production of neutrons per second and provided a realistic simulation of plasma-created neutrons. "It mimicked a ring of neutron emission that is most like the shape of the neutron emitting region of NSTX plasmas," Darrow said. And since the source was securely encapsulated, it made any possibility of a radiation release very remote.

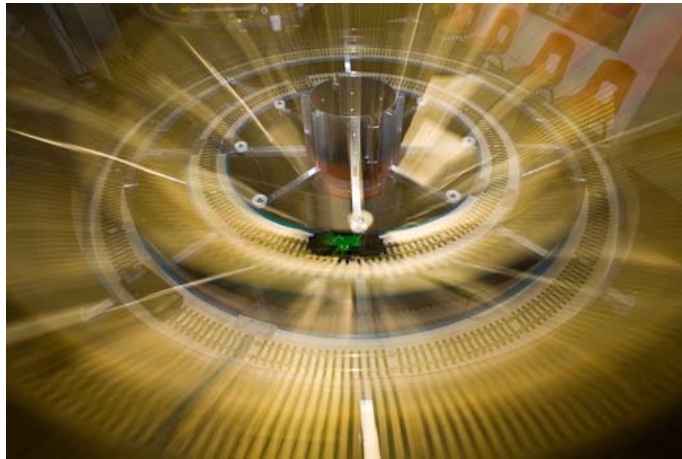
PPPL developed the idea to use toy trains for neutron calibrations several

years ago. Researchers have since used the method on fusion machines at the Lab and at other fusion research institutions.

"A model train may sound low tech, but it provides us with exactly the right arrangement we need for this calibration," said Darrow. "Besides, thousands of hobbyists have tested it before us so it has high reliability for this job." Choo-Choo!

Installing Ball Bearings in the ART29101 Freight Truck

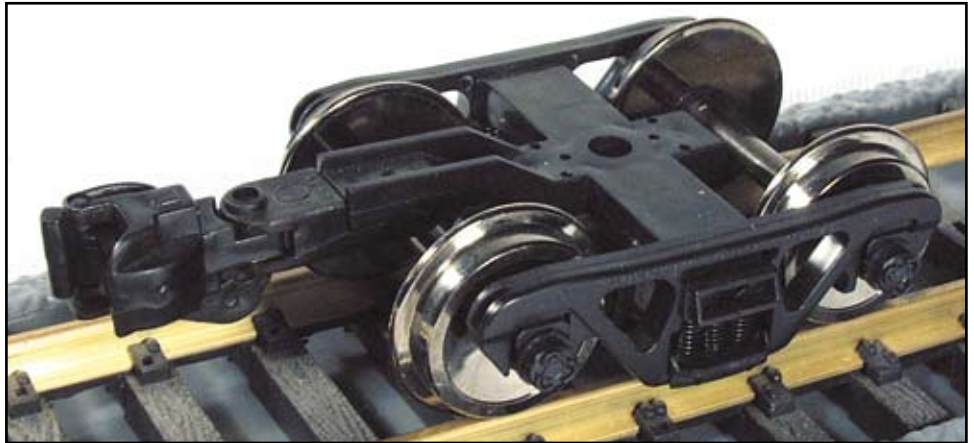

This is part two of an article written about installing ball bearings into Aristo-Craft freight trucks. Last issue, we looked at Aristo-Craft's Modern Freight Truck. This article will deal with the freight trucks that have been on the Aristo-Craft freight cars (ART 29101 with plastic wheels and no coupler).

As with any process, this is not the only way it can be done. In fact, it is not exactly the way I was taught. I have had great success with this method and continue to use it. I probably have installed over 300 of these bearing in my freight trucks and some friends' freight trucks, as well. The nice thing about this method is you do not have to drill to get them to fit.

In fact, you do not have to take the trucks off of the car to install these, but it becomes a 'handful' leaving the trucks on the car.

The ball bearings that fit into the ART29101 freight truck is Aristo-Craft number ART29411. These ball bearing come in tubes of 10.

This tube retails for \$20.00. In order to do this project you will need the following: 1 Phillips head screw-

driver; 1 course threaded long dry-wall screw; 1 tube of ART # 29411 ball bearings; and one pair of vise grips. (If you are careful, you do not even have to take the side frame apart to install these bearing.)

First take the truck off the car with a Phillips screwdriver. Once I have the truck off the car, I usually put the Phillips screw back in the car with a

couple of turns to make sure I don't lose that screw.) Gently pull the trucks apart at the axle, where the wheels are, far enough for the wheel to drop out of that end of the truck (see Fig.1). Then remove the wheel and axle from that side of the truck. Then do the same on the other side of the truck.

Now that you have your wheel sets out of the truck, take your vise grips (see Fig. 2) and screw open the jaws enough to fit over the axle hole and the outside of the truck. Make it so when they close they do not crush the side frame. Next, take the long drywall screw and twist it into the hole the axle came out of (see Fig 3.). Twist it by hand and pull gently. The plastic 'sleeve' should start to come out. Pull it all the way out of the side frame. Again don't pull with your full force. Once you get all 4 of the plastic sleeves/bushings out of that

truck, now get 4 of the ball bearings out of the tube. Place one of the bearings over the hole where the sleeve/bushing came out. Take the opened vise grips and gently squeeze the bearing down into the hole that the plastic sleeve came out of. Try to squeeze it level into the side frame. It does not take a lot of force to get it to squeeze into the side frame. Once you have all 4 bearings in the truck, then install the wheels. Put one axle in the bearing and then gently spread the side frame apart to get the other axle into the opposite side bearing. Once you have completed this task for both trucks, then re-install the trucks on to the car.

I conducted an experiment and recorded the statistics for this experiment. To conduct this experiment, I laid 4 FIVE foot sections together (see Fig 4.). I put one of the "Easy Loader" on the end of the track and

then stretched out a 30 foot tape measure so I could measure the distance traveled. I let the car roll down the "Easy Loader" and recorded how far it traveled each time.

I conducted this experiment five times one way and then turned the car around and let it roll down again five times. (I called the brake wheel end of the car the "A" end and the other end the "B" end.)

On the "A" end, the lowest distance traveled was 43 inches and the furthest was 51 inches for an average of 45.8 inches. The "B" end's low was 44 inches and the longest was 48 inches for an average of 46.4 inches. Figuring both ends together with plastic wheels, the total average was 46.1 inches.

I then removed the plastic wheels and install just metal wheels. "A" side's shortest was 68 inches and the longest was 77 inches. The average with metal wheels on the "A" side was 72.8 inches. The "B" side went from 61 to 72 inches for a "B" side average of 65.6 inches. Both sides all averaged together were 69.2 inches.

Now we removed the metal wheels, removed the plastic sleeve, installed ball bearings and then the metal wheels. The stats for the "A" side was 94 to 114 inches which had an average of 103.2 inches. The "B" side went from 98 to 107 inches for an average of 103 inches. Both ends collectively, the total average was 103.1 inches.

I found this next piece of information interesting. I put the level on the track

which was on the floor. The bubble was between the two 'level hairs' but touched the one end hair. I always picked up the car after it stopped rolling forward and took it back for the next rolling. The very last rolling, with metal wheels and ball bearings, I did not pick it up because I was writing down the last batch of numbers. I looked up and the car was rolling backwards. It rolled all the way back to the "Easy Loader." So for all three experiments, the car was rolling uphill through all of the experiments.

So what are some of the benefits of installing ball bearings in your freight cars? They have much less drag than the plastic wheels and will roll almost twice as far as just metal wheels and about 3 times as far as plastic wheels. Not only do you gain the less drag, but you can pull more cars on your train with out strain. Also less drag on your engines. I know and have heard, "They are too expensive for me to do my whole rolling stock. Remember, you can run some cars with metal wheels and ball bearings with those with just metal wheels. As I told you in the previous article, I purchased a couple tubes at a time and before too long I had many of my cars installed with metal wheels and ball bearings.

I hope you will try a couple to see how easy they are to install and how much better they make your trains run. As the one TV commercial says, "Try them, and I bet you will like them!"

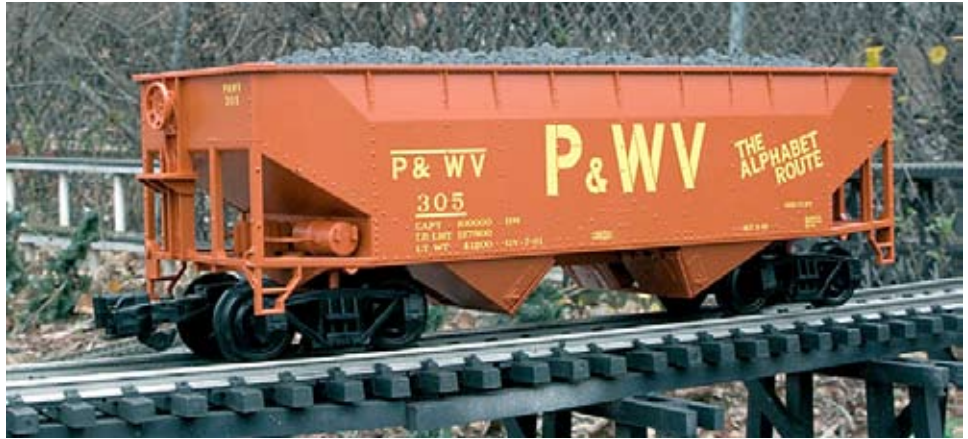

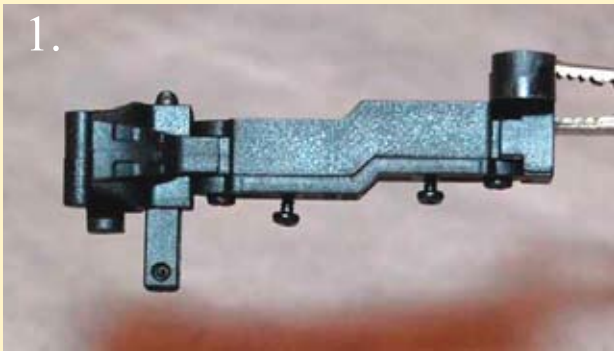
The Kuppler: A Pictorial Review

Sometime toward the middle of November 2009, a package from Philadelphia mysteriously showed up on the table on my back patio. Inside this mysterious package were 3 pairs of the new Aristo-Craft Kupplers. I was most excited to see how these much discussed Kupplers would work. As I opened the package, I was quite impressed with the quality of the product which had been well thought out and well-machined. Each individual package included 2 complete Kupplers plus parts.



I had 2 or 3 cars that needed new couplers so I decided to try my first Kuppler installation. The coupler has some extraordinary features in that the shanks are quite long and very flexible. They are very different from any coupler on the market today... Rather than try to explain them with many words, I'll do my best to describe them with images. The images may be larger than normal but that way you'll be able to see how they work.



As it comes from the package, you'll notice the 2 screws extending from the bottom of the shank. When screwed completely in, they will lock the shank and/or the knuckle from swinging.



In addition to the 2 screws that are visible above, there are 2 more screws in the bottom. These will allow you to take the coupler completely apart and configure it into many different variations.

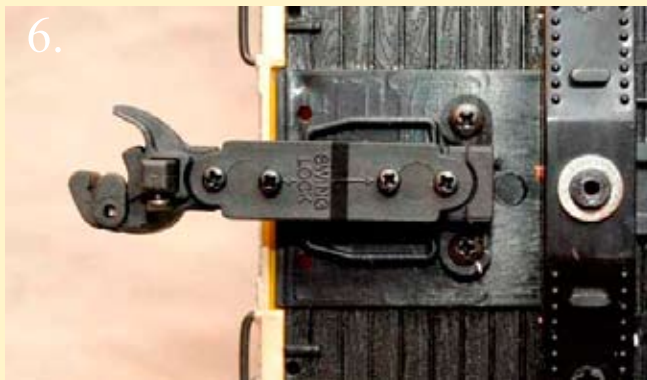


The coupler shank and the knuckle will swing to give a wide range of movement for smaller radius curves. For this image, the knuckle and the shank were locked by the locking screws to keep them in position.

The entire assembly can be easily taken apart and put back together in many variations for many different applications. I disassembled the entire Kuppler in less than 30 seconds. This will allow the knuckle to be turned over as well as the mounting bracket. The variations are many as shown below.



As mentioned earlier, this is a great looking product but just how easy is it to install the Kuppler and how does it work with the other knuckle couplers in the hobby. The first installation was on a 40 foot Aristo-Craft stock car.

I took the truck off, saw the 2 mounting holes just after the mounting plate, placed the out of the package Kuppler over the holes, drilled a 1/16th pilot hole for each screw and mounted the Kuppler with the screws provided in the package. That operation took about a minute and how did it match with a standard Kadee?



This image shows the shank has been inverted, as well as the knuckle and the mounting bracket. This allows for many different mounting applications and coupler matching situations. The plate and screws will be reassembled before use. Compare this image with the one at the beginning of the article.



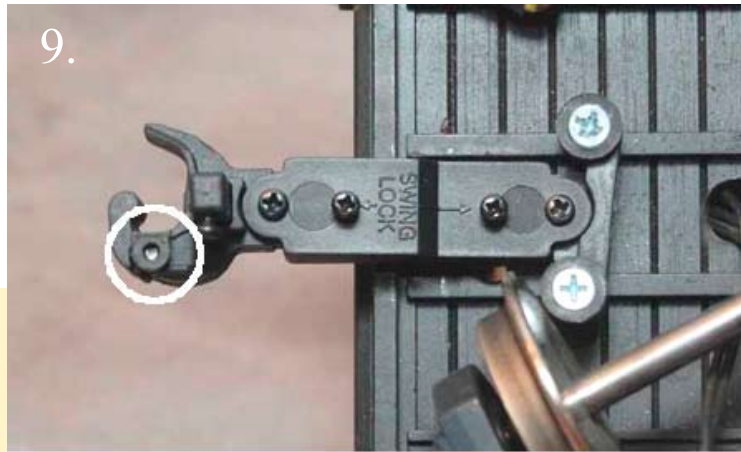
Perfectly! Next was to match it with a standard Aristo-Craft knuckle coupler as this is the battery car for the GP40. How did this match?



Perfectly! Gee, this is kind of fun. Let's see what else we can do....

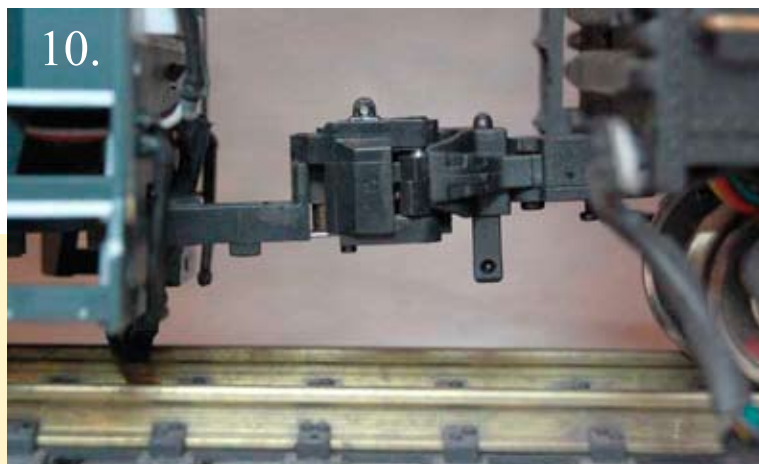

The next application was on an LGB boxcar. The Kuppler needed to be modified for this one. I had to invert the knuckle, turn the shank over and change the mounting bracket to so it would set on the 2 brackets on the bottom of the car. I used two #4 x 3/4 inch flat head sheet metal screws to mount the Kuppler after drilling a 1/16th inch pilot hole for each screw. How did this one match up? Not quite perfectly.

The reason it didn't match quite perfectly is because the LGB knuckle is longer (more massive) than the Kuppler knuckle and the little tab on the Kuppler that keeps all other couplers matched would not allow the Kuppler knuckle to close. So I just cut it off. See the circle above. After this operation was completed, how did the Kuppler match with LGB?



These Kuppler to coupler applications have been running for many hours on our layout without a single uncoupling incident. I'm quite pleased with the ease of installation, the availability of different configurations, reliability when running and the match up with other knuckle couplers on the market today. The body mounting style for the Kuppler is unique and as with any new product, it will take some thought for each application except for mounting on Aristo-Craft rolling stock with the mounting plate and mounting holes. I've successfully matched the Kuppler with knuckles manufactured by Aristo-Craft, Bachmann, Kadee, LGB, Lionel and USA.
